When do we use "Have" and when do we use "Has?"

I HAVE YOU HAVE WE HAVE THEY HAVE

HE HAS SHE HAS IT HAS

**EXAMPLES** 

## I HAVE A PENCIL. SHE HAS A PENCIL.

## **CONTRACTION TIPS**



Contraction Tip # 1

I have — I've

Use this if the action is already done. Example: I have eaten.

**Contraction 2** 

I have I have

Use this if it is something you own. Example: I have a dog.

## NEGATIVE FORM OF "HAVE".

We use "do not have" or "does not have." We can make contractions too!

I DO NOT HAVE
I DON'T HAVE
YOU DO NOT HAVE
YOU DON'T HAVE



HE DOES NOT HAVE HE DOESN'T HAVE SHE DOES NOT HAVE SHE DOESN'T HAVE

Use "don't or doesn't + have" only for possession of something. Example: I don't have a toy.

Use "haven't or hasn't + action verb" only with an action done. Example: I haven't eaten dinner yet.
