

MS. SENIOR AMERICA, LLC SHOWCASE INSTRUCTIONS

CHOOSE YOUR TALENT PRESENTATION

Showcase presentations should show the audience what you do when you entertain in a non-theatrical facility, such as a hospital day room or nursing home, where you have little to work with other than your talent! Your talent must be suitable for any children in audience.

Solo acts are limited to 2 minutes, 45 seconds.

Performers will be provided with the use of the microphones already available in the theater, but special request will be considered.

If you've been in the National Pageant or performed in the Talent Showcase in the past, we may already have the music for the song you did. If you are doing the same song, you will not need to upload your music.

If we don't already have your music, you will have to provide an MP3 file with your selection.

Complete applications will be accepted in order of the date they are received, and cut off when all time slots are filled. This form and music must be received by **September 10**th.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

All performers must purchase tickets, which will be available through the Pageant Main Office.

Check in for the Talent Showcase at the Tropicana Resorts Pageant Office no later than noon. Have your Talent Showcase ticket with you. You MUST CHECK IN at the Tropicana Resorts Pageant Office to let us know that you are present. IF YOU DO NOT CHECK IN, YOUR TIME SLOT MAY BE RE-ASSIGNED.

All performers should arrive at the Showcase Room door, (to be announced at a later date) at 6:00 pm on the day of the Showcase,
