Tahajjud Salah

Tahajjud Salah is a special night prayer. The best time to pray Tahajjud Salah is in the last third of the night.

Allah Ta'ala's special Mercy comes down during the last third of the night. Peoples duas and forgiveness is accepted by Allah Ta'ala.

During the last third of the night Allah Ta'ala says:

"Is there anyone who will make dua unto to me so that I may accept his dua?

Is there anyone who wants to ask from me so that I can give him?

Is there anyone who wants forgiveness so that I may forgive him?"

Tahajjud Salah

In Islam the night starts from Maghrib and ends at the beginning of Fajr. The best time to perform Tahajjud Salah is in the last third of the night.

We will divide the night into three parts. For example If Maghrib is at 6 pm and Fajr is at 6 am then last third of the night will start at 2 am.

Lets work out the last third of the night

6 pm to 6 am = 12 hours

12 hours \div 3 = 4 hours

6 pm to 10 pm (First 4 hours) = First part of the night

10 pm to 2 am (Second 4 hours) = Second part of the night

2 am to 6 am (Third 4 hours) = Third part of the night

Special virtue of the 15th Night of Sha'ban

Every night, Allah Ta'ala's special mercy comes down during the last third of the night. However, on the night of 15th Sha'ban the mercy and forgiveness from Allah Ta'ala begins from the start of Maghrib and continues till the start of Fajr.

Therefore, every Muslim should pray Tahajjud, repent and ask forgiveness from Allah, the most Merciful. Every Muslim should ask forgiveness from Allah Ta'ala for himself, his family and all the Muslims, those who are living and who have passed away.
