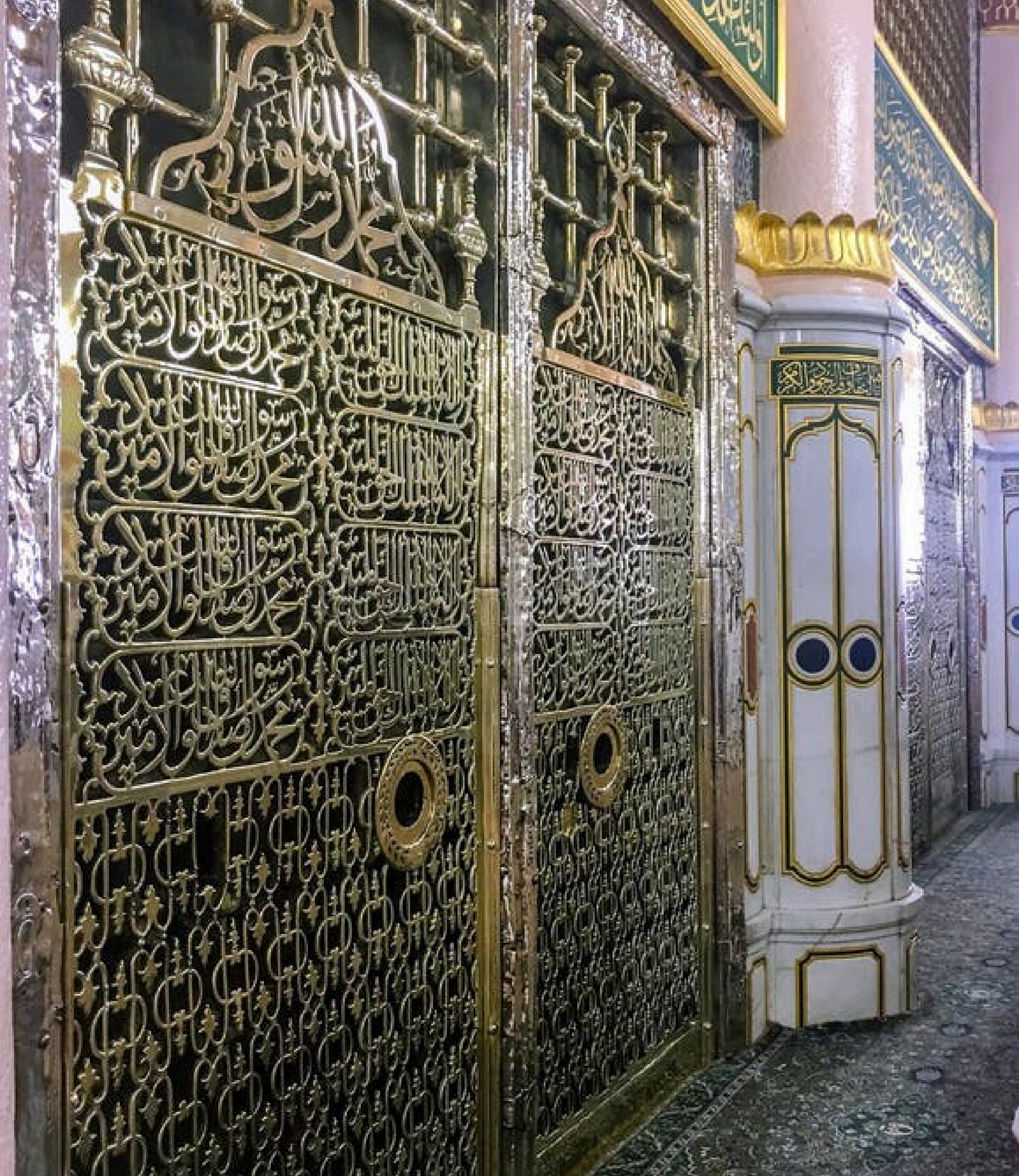
The Green Dome over the resting place of the Prophet ﷺ

House of Ja'far ibn Abi Talib رضي الله عنه

House of Nawfal ibn al-Harith رضي الله عنه

**Note: The house of Ammar ibn Yasir رضي الله عنه
was located on the left, as soon as you
enter Bab us Salam, opposite direction of
the Qibla wall.**









This is the approximate location where one of the houses of Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه existed. Opposite the Qibla wall.

The Eastern house of Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه and the house of Khalid ibn al-Walid رضي الله عنه



Some parts of the house of Abu Bakr رضي الله عنه are situated inside, while other parts are located outside. The house of Khalid ibn al-Walid رضي الله عنه is also located in Bab Bilal, gate 38.



Bab Jibraeel



Angel Jibraeel **عليه السلام** used to descend from this side with the Wahi (revelation).

Bab un Nisa



Bab un Nisa was commissioned by Umar رضي الله عنه
for exclusive use by women.



This is the approximate location of the
house of Abu Ayyub al-Ansari رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ



The Prophet ﷺ used to lead Salat-ul-Janaza at this site.



The house of Uthman ibn Affan رضي الله عنه was situated just outside Bab ul Baqi.



House of Umar ibn al-Khattab رضي الله عنه is located outside door 3 (Bab ur Rahmah), as you walk towards door 4 (Bab ul Hijrah).

The House of Hafsah رَضِيَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهَا in Bab us Salam (door 1)



The house of Hafsah رَضِيَ اللَّهُ تَعَالَى عَنْهَا used to
exist here. She was the wife of the
Prophet ﷺ and the daughter of Umar رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ

Some of the Important Landmarks in the Rawdha – **Riadhul Jannah** –





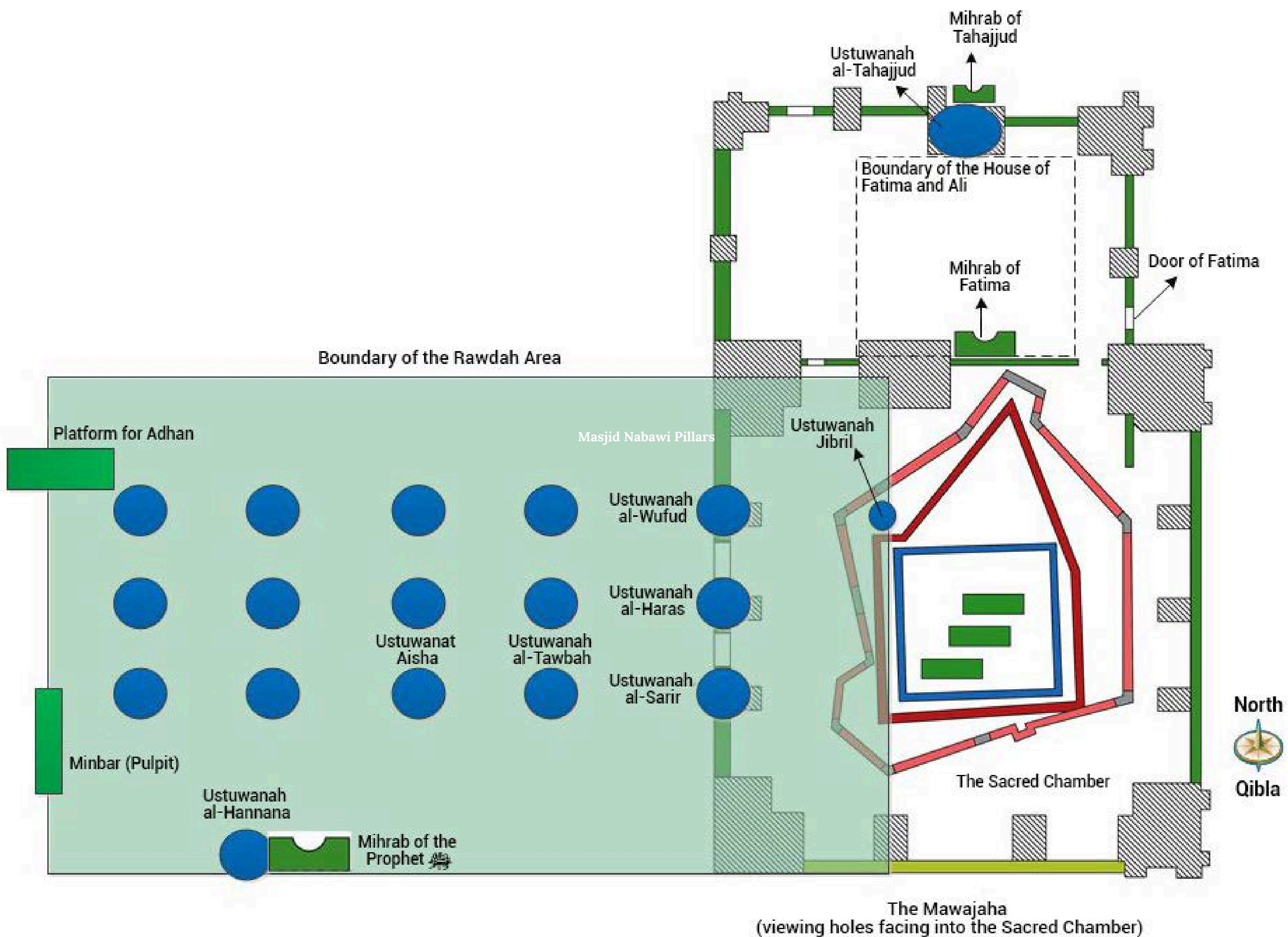
The Mihrab of Tahajjud, Rasulullah ﷺ would perform his Tahajjud here.



Ustuwanah Mukhallaqah

It is on this spot where there used to be a date palm tree. Before the mimbar was made, the Prophet ﷺ used to lean on it while delivering the khutbah.

Mihrab Uthmani is located in Bab us Salam

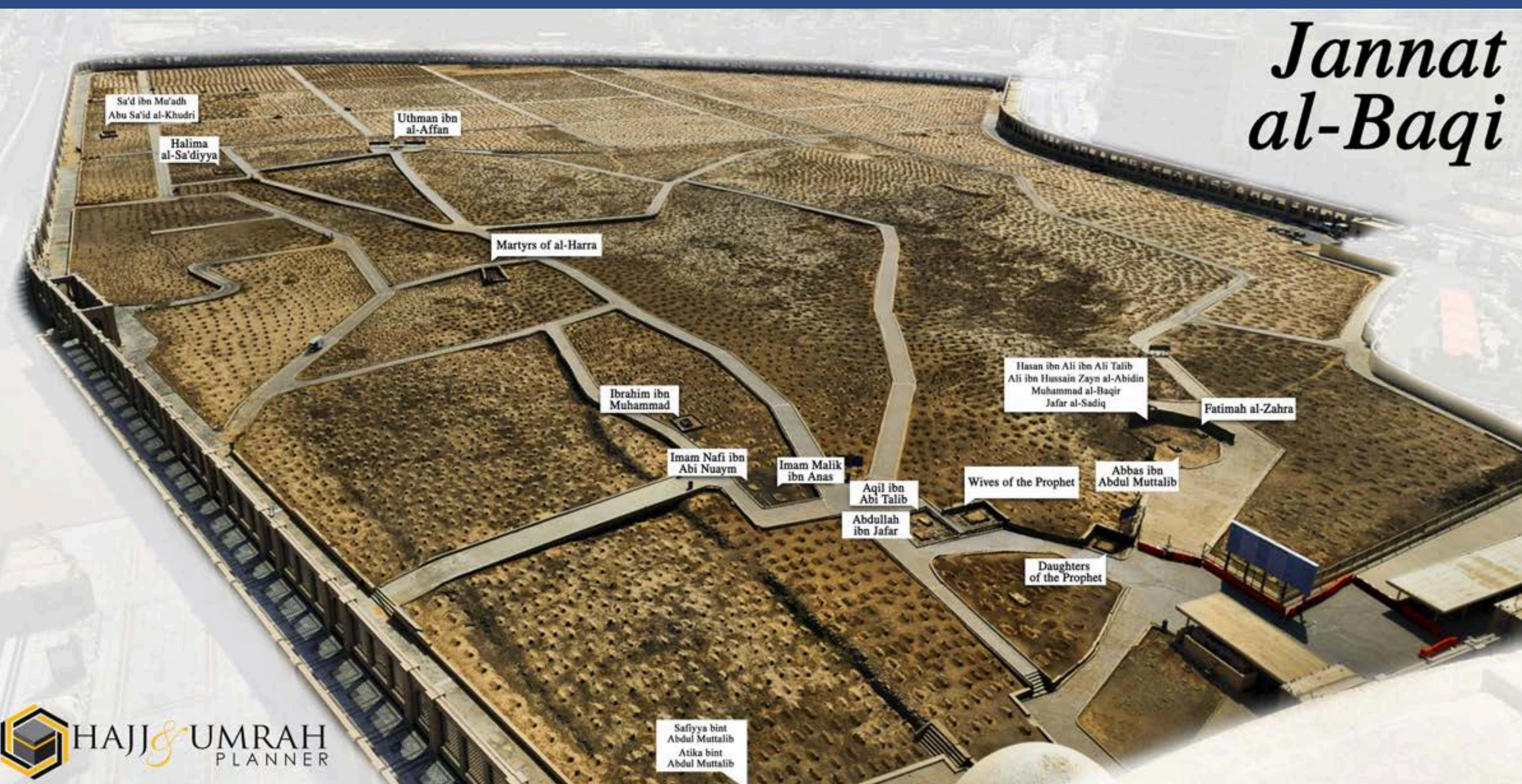


Mihrab Uthmani is the functional
