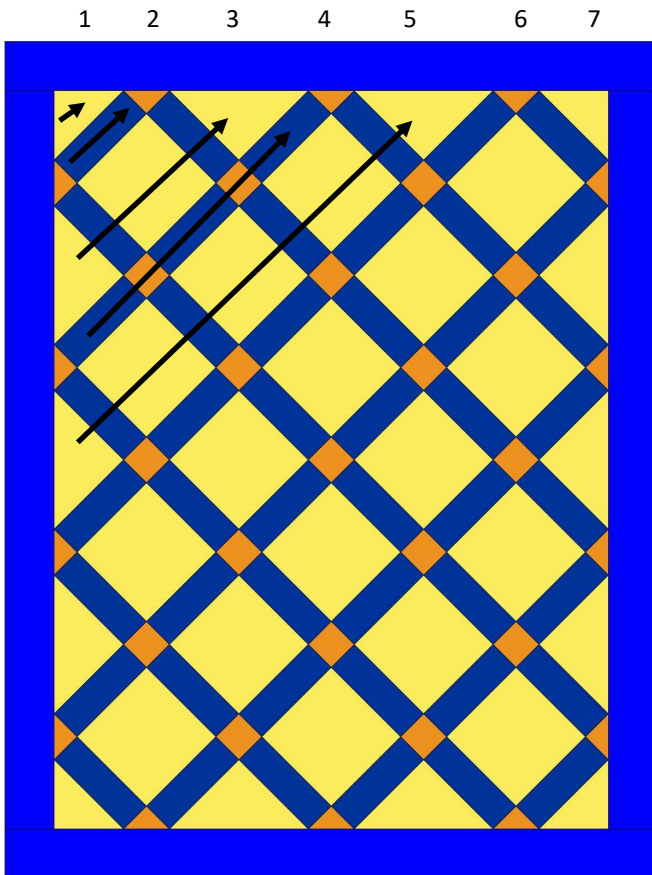


On-point Charm Quilt



40 x 50 finished size

- 8 (32) 6.5in squares (1 1/8 yd)
- 9 (31) 2.5in squares (1/4 yd)
- 10 (48) 6.5 x 2.5 sashing strips (3/4 yd)
- 11 (2) 44.5 x 3.5 borders
- 12 (2) 40.5 x 3.5 borders (1/2 yd)
- 13 (5) 2.5in strips for binding (1/2 yd)
- 14
- 15

Create on-point rows. Row 1, one 6.5 in square. Row 2, two corner stones and one sashing strip. Row 3, three 6.5 in squares and two sashing strips. Continue in the same manner until all 19 rows are completed.

Sew the rows together. Trim off the extra fabric by lining up the quarter inch mark on your ruler with the intersection of the squares, leaving a quarter inch seam allowance for the border seams.

Add the long borders first, easing in the quilt top to fit the border strip. Add the top and bottom borders, again easing in the top to fit the borders.
