LIST OF MOBILE EQUIPMENT ON HAND AS OF September 13, 2017

ALL APPARATUS IN SERVICE ARE CURRENTLY OPERATIONAL

- 2501- Rescue/Service Apparatus - 94 Chevrolet truck, diesel engine, new tires and is in very good condition. The tank and pump system are in new condition.
1. This vehicle will be next out for all incidents since it has a repeater for enhanced communication.
  2. Carries equipment to support accident scenes.
    - a. Power extrication set and cribbing. (Cribbing is still a future item for this apparatus.)
    - b. Generator set and lights for additional scene lighting.
  3. Carries 750 gallons of water to fire scenes.
  4. Has 200 feet of red-line for reaching distant scene areas.
  5. Has connection for 2 ½ "or 1 ½" hose.
- 2502- Engine/Rescue Apparatus - 2005 E-One, Freightliner chassis, Mercedes/Benz (Detroit) diesel engine, automatic transmission, 1250 gpm Hale pump and 1000 gallon water tank. Scheduled for new tires.
1. First out for structure fires.
  2. First out for rescue missions. Extrication tools are on board.
  3. Next out for wildland fire support.
  4. Carries equipment for structure fires and rescue tools and cribbing.
  5. Carries 1000 gallons of water for use on structures, rescues or for re-filling wildland brush trucks.
- 2503- Wildland Brush Apparatus - 97 Chevrolet, gas engine and new tires. Apparatus is operational. Has 300 gallon un baffled water tank. This apparatus should be replaced in the future. Operators are trained to be careful while operating due to movement of water in tank. This apparatus has a manual transmission which can be difficult for some operators.
1. First out for wildland fires, first responder, accident and mutual aid calls.
  2. Carries 300 gallons of water and wildland fire gear.
  3. Carries First Aid Kit and AED for first responder calls.
  4. Carries a set of lights for setting up Landing Zones (LZ) at night.
- 2504- Wildland Brush Apparatus - 04 Ford F550.
1. First out for wildland fires, first responder, accident and mutual aid calls.
  2. Next out for structure fires.
  3. Carries 400 gallons of water and wildland fire gear.
  4. Carries First Aid Kit and an AED for first responder calls.
  5. Carries a set of lights for setting up Landing Zones (LZ) at night.
  6. Has GPS installed.
  7. Carries a suction pump for drafting operations.

- 2505- Heavy Wildland Brush Apparatus - 81 BMY military 5 ton truck.
1. Next out for all fires and mutual aid.
  2. Carries 1000 gallons of water and wildland fire fighting gear.
  3. Fills in as tender for smaller brush trucks.
  4. Carries a 2500 Gallon Portable Water Tank.
- 2506- Wildland Brush Apparatus - 90 GMC.
1. First out for wildland fires, first responder, accident and mutual aid calls.
  2. Carries 250 gallons of water.
  3. Carries wildland firefighting equipment.
  4. Carries a First Aid Kit and an AED for First Responder calls.
  5. Carries a set of lights for setting up a Landing Zone (LZ) at night.
  6. Has 100 ft of 1 ½" hose on board.
  7. GPS installed.
- 2507- Wildland Brush Apparatus- 2017 Ford. The grant for which we have been waiting has now been received. Contract was completed with AMI on 11-12-2016. The chassis has been received and is at the build shop. Final build meeting occurred on September 12, 2017.
1. First out for wildland fires, first responder, accident and mutual aid calls.
  2. Carries 400 gallons of water
  3. Carries wildland firefighting equipment
  4. Carries First Aid Kit and AED for First Responder calls.
  5. Carries a set of lights for setting up a Landing Zone (LZ) at night.
  6. Has 100 feet of 1 ½" hose on board.
- 2508- Engine -1997 Spartan Gladiator.
1. First out for structure fire calls in the LCR 750 station area.
  2. Second out for accident, wildland fires and mutual aid calls.
  3. Carries 1000 gallons of water.
  4. Carries 850 feet of 2 ½ " hose.
  5. Carries 250 feet of 1 ½ " hose in the cross lays.
  6. Carries 100 feet of 1 ½" hose in the bumper.
  7. Other items will be added as they are available to enhance the usage of this apparatus.
- 2503- Heavy Brush Truck-1994 Stewart and Stevenson 2 ½ ton truck. This truck will replace the current 2503. The vehicle is at NEEL Fire for conversion to a Brush Truck. Currently the truck is in the build shop and should be complete by end of month September.
