• This Symbol Means this game is postable as well as scoreable for Anita Conklin ECCE. (No putts may be given other than in match play)

April 1 Team Mixer A B C D: Blind Draw 9:00 Shotgun 2:00 Meeting

SCRAMBLE: Each player tees off each hole. The best shot is selected and all players move their balls to that location and hit their next shot from that position. This continues until the ball is holed. Three drives must be used by each player. Golf Shop divides players into A, B, C and D groups by handicap before being assigned to foursomes. *Low net winners*

April 8 Partner Competition: 2-day (pick your partner)

• TWO DAY BEST BALL ECCE: Each player plays their own ball. Teams limited to no more than a 10-stroke difference in course handicaps between the team players. Use best net score of the team

April 15 Partner Competition: second day

• TEAM ECCE: Teams try to improve their net score on each hole compared with 1st day scores. Winners are the teams with the lowest overall 18-hole net score for the two days. *Low net in flights*

April 22 Partner Competition: Pick your partner

ONE CLUB PLUS PUTTER: For each hole, select only one club plus putter from your bag to play the entire hole. One best ball of the twosome. Can use for ECCE, Owls, Birdies, 29 Club. *Low net in flights*

April 29 Team Competition Foursomes: Pick your team 9:00 Shotgun

 RUN FOR THE MONEY: Most net pars for the team. Kentucky Derby Roses presented for best team hats following competition.
Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal

May 6 Partner Competition: Meet & Greet the Pro and getting to know you. The Pro will play a par 3 with you. Record all players' scores, but may use the pro's score for the team competition if it's the lowest score.

• GETTING TO KNOW YOU: Each player selects a partner with whom she did not play with in 2024. Use best-ball scoring. (Course handicaps of members may not differ by more than ten strokes.) *Low net in flights*

May 13 Team Mixer A B C D: Blind Draw

9:00 Shotgun 2:00 Opening Luncheon & Meeting

 TANUM 6: Foursomes play this game in three sections: On holes 1-6: record three best net scores of the foursome On holes 7-12: record two best net scores of the foursome On holes 13-18: record one best net score of the foursome Low net winners

May 20 Individual Competition:

• REJECTS: Record your gross scores. Your three highest gross and net scores will be dropped at the end of the round. *Low gross and net* in flights Plus: WSWGA Elizabeth Dwan Memorial Trophy

May 27 Individual Competition:

• LOW GROSS & LOW NET: *Pays low gross and net in flights* Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal

June 3 Individual Competition:

MATCH VS PAR: Use handicap strokes as they fall on the card and play against net par. If your score on the hole is:
Same as par = even (0 points)
 Less than par = plus one
 More than par = minus one
 High scores in flights win
 Plus: WSWGA Match vs Par

June 10Individual Competition: Sign up in Golf Shop (must play both days)Sign up in advance so Golf Shop can make pairings

• CAPTAIN'S CUP: This is our championship Gross and Net Tournament. Combined individual gross and net score for two days of stroke play. First day of play, pairings are by handicap. (Above if passed by April Vote)

June 17Individual Competition: Golf Shop will make pairings9:00 Shotgun 2:00 Meeting Second day of Captain's Cup Play

• CAPTAIN'S CUP FINAL ROUND: Second day pairings, determined by 1st day net scores. Lowest net scores tee off last. *Winners = top 25% of the field up to a maximum of 5 places in both Gross and Net.(Prior to net payout, pull out top 5 Gross places.)* (Above if passed by April Vote)

June 24 Individual Competition:

• BEST 16: Throw out 2 highest gross & net scores. *Low gross and net in flights* Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal

July 1 Partner Competition: Pick your partner

MACHO GIRLS: Choose a tee box on each hole. Score net par or better from the red tees = 1 point. Net par or better from white tees = 2 points. Net par or better from blue tees = 3 points. Golf shop will dot cards using handicap strokes as they fall on the red tees. Pick up after net double bogey. Partners may play from different tees on each hole. Counts for ECCE, Owls, Birdies and 29 Club. *Pays highest score winners*

July 8 Individual Competition:

• HALF & HALF: Add front nine net score plus back nine putts. *Low net plus putts in flights*

July 15Team Mixer A B C D:Blind Draw9:00 Shotgun plus 2:00 Meeting

• CHA CHA CHA: Count one low net on 1st hole, two low nets on 2nd hole, three low nets on 3rd hole and begin again on 4th hole. *Low net winners*

July 22 Individual Competition:

• HIGHEST HANDICAP HOLES: Scores on holes with handicaps 10-18 will be totaled. *Low gross and net in flights*

July 29 Individual Competition:

• LOWEST HANDICAP HOLES: Scores on holes with handicap 1-9 will be totaled. *Low gross and net* in flights Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal.

August 5 Ladies Invitational Two Day Tournament

MATCH-PLAY TWO WOMEN PER TEAM: Three nine-hole matches. Members may play with other members or with guests. Non-members may play with other nonmembers. Registration open to members before being sent out to non-members. Maximum course handicap = 36 (may play, but will not be credited with more than 36 handicap).

Partners may play with more than a 10-point handicap difference, but the higher handicap player will be limited to not more than 10 strokes more than her partner's course handicap.

August 6Day Two of Ladies Invitational Tournament, and Award LuncheonMATCH PLAY TWO WOMEN PER TEAM: Two nine-hole matches.

August 12 Individual Competition:

• USELESS BAY CRUISE: All players who "Cruise" into the clubhouse with a total net score under 74 will be winners and split the pot.

August 19 Partner Competition: 2-days (pick your partner)

• TWO DAY BEST BALL ECCE: Each player plays HER OWN BALL. Maximum 10-stroke difference in course handicaps between the team players. Use best gross and net scores on each hole. Plus: WSWGA All State Medal

August 26 Partner Competition: 2nd day:

 PARTNER ECCE: Teams try to improve gross & net score on each hole compared with 1st day scores. Pays the teams with the lowest overall 18 hole gross & 18 hole net score for the two days. Low gross & net in flights. Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal.

Sept. 2 Course closed due to aerification

Sept. 9Partner Competition: Pick your partner you have not played with in2025

FOUR CLUBS ONLY: Player chooses four clubs from bag and uses those for the 18 holes. Putter counts as one club. (CAN be used for ECCE, Owls, Birdies and 29 Club.) One best ball of the twosome. *Low net in flights*

Sept. 16 Team Mixer A B C D: Blind Draw 9:00 Shotgun 2:00 Meeting

• AVERAGE JANE: Record each player's gross score. Take the average total score for the foursome at the end. Threesomes will be assigned a blind draw. Golf Genius will be computing your team's average score. *Pays low net winners*

Sept. 23 Individual Competition:

• MUTT AND JEFF: The total score of the par 3's and par 5's will be counted. *Pays gross and net in flights* Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal

Sept. 30 Individual Competition:

 CRISS CROSS: Players will compare their net scores for corresponding holes on the front and back (1 against 10, 2 against 11, etc) and choose the better of the two to create a 9-hole score. *Low net in flights* Plus: WSWGA State Monthly Medal

LAST DAY FOR ANITA CONKLIN ECCE, ACES, BIRDIES, OWLS AND 29 CLUB.

October 7 Three Individual Competitions: Tournament Chair will send out a list of who is eligible for each of the competitions prior to signups.

- 1. ACES: Low net of the month players, paired by the Golf Shop compete for Ace of the year. Stroke play, winner = Low net score of the field.
- 2. CRIERS: Players who have not placed in the Individual Monthly Match Play or Captain's Cup Tournaments. Winner = Low net score of the field.
- 3. WHINERS: Those not playing in above. Entry fee will be charged. Pays most points. Stableford scoring. Net score on each hole. *Earn points as follows:*

1-Bogie 2-Par 3-Birdie 4-Eagle 5-Dbl. Eagle 10 hole in one

October 14 Team Competition Foursome: Pick your team 9:00 Shotgun 2:00 Awards Luncheon and Meeting

CROSS COUNTRY SCRAMBLE: New holes are created by moving tee boxes and combining tees and greens from different holes. (must use 3 drives from each player) *Low net*

October 21 Individual Competition:

• FEWEST PUTTS: Total all putts. Only putts on the green count. No handicap used for this competition. *Pays fewest putts (not flighted)*

October 28 Individual Competition: no entry fee - covered in annual dues

• TURKEY SHOOT: 3 low net winners in 3 flights Cash payouts
