Listen up, all you fabulous Flappers! It's time to get a wiggle on and mark your calendars because registration for the 103rd Washington State Women's Golf Association (WSWGA) State Championship opens May 15 at 7:00 PM sharp.

This year's championship is the bee's knees, taking place at Meadow Springs Country Club in Richland, Washington, from July 21–23, 2025. This three-day stroke play event is sure to be the cat's pajamas, bringing big hitters, smooth swings, and plenty of razzmatazz!

Here's the Lowdown:

- Field Limit: 96 competitors – first come, first served!
- Maximum Course Handicap: 34
- Eligibility: Must meet WSWG requirements. Must have 10 rounds played/posted in previous 12 months prior to tournament.
- Entry Fee: \$290 per competitor
- Includes a practice round, access to the driving range & putting area with complimentary balls, comfort stations on the course.

Registration & Tournament Management

All the whoopee happens electronically via Golf Genius—no muss, no fuss! Be prepared! You will need your email address and password to complete the registration process. If the field fills up, we'll have a waitlist ready for anyone hoping to join us.

In order to be eligible to play in this tournament:

All contestants must be a member of a club which allows full golfing privileges and belongs to the Washington State Women's Golf Association.

All contestants must have an approved USGA handicap index. This index is then converted to a handicap for the course where the tournament is being played. Players with handicaps of 34 and under shall be eligible for the tournament.

Players must have 10 rounds played and posted in the previous 12 months prior to the entry cut-off date.

All contestants shall be eighteen (18) years of age or older as of the first day of the tournament.

Transgender athletes may compete in the WSWGGA State Championship if the athlete provides a signed declaration that they comply with both puberty and hormone level and/or use requirements as specified in section 4 of the USGA Competitive Fairness Gender Policy. Transgender athletes may request this declaration from their club trustees.

Finally, players who sign up for the tournament should have a working knowledge of the basic rules of golf.
