St. Hubert's Church

There will be no church service at St. Hubert's on Sunday August 15 due to the fact that Pinedale will be having a Ranch Mass at the Murdock Ranch. The service will be at 11am and we are requested to bring our own lawn chairs. After the service there will be a potluck. Meat will be provided, please bring a side dish or dessert, as well as your own plate and silverware. If you would like to carpool with fellow Bondurant-ites (is that a word?), please meet at St. Hubert's parking lot at 9:30am. Otherwise, here are the directions to the Murdock Ranch:

Directions: Leaving Pinedale, drive 1 mile west (toward Jackson), to Ehman Lane (Co. Hwy. 144). Turn right, north, drive 2.2 miles. Turn right across cattle guard, immediately veer left across 2nd cattle guard on to Murdock Ranch Road. At fork in road, stay right, climbing hill to Mad's house. Distance from 1st cattle guard to house is 2 miles. Allow 15 minutes driving time from Pinedale.

If coming from the west, heading toward Pinedale, cross the New Fork River bridge, then take 1st left onto Ehman Lane. Then, as above.

Also, the church has received funding for necessary improvements and work will begin in the fall.
