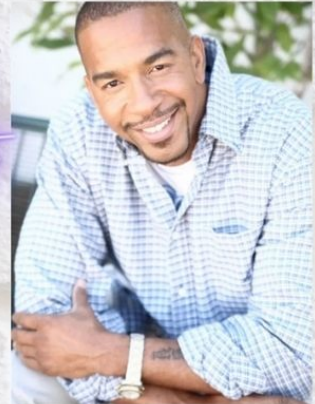
## PTSD AWARENESS MONTH
