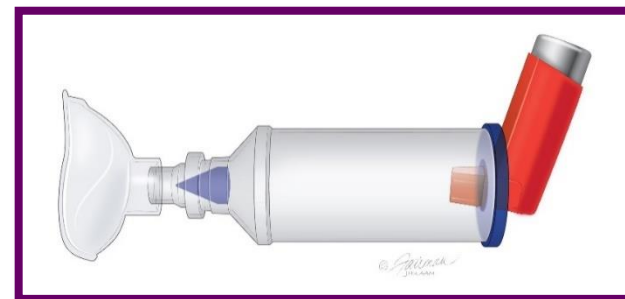

These medicines help prevent symptoms long term by controlling the swelling in the airways. These medicines may be prescribed to be taken every day and should not be used for quick relief of symptoms. Some of these medicines can take up to a few weeks of regular use to begin working, so be sure to take them exactly as the doctor prescribes.

To prevent thrush, rinse the mouth out with water after taking these medicines.



Every child who uses an inhaler should use a spacer. Some controller medicines, like Pulmicort or QVAR, may not work with a spacer. Ask your child's doctor or pharmacist if you are unsure if their medicine will be right for a spacer.
