

TLILIC0001 Licence to transport dangerous goods by road

OVERVIEW

This unit equips learners with the skills and knowledge required to obtain a Dangerous Goods (DG) driver licence to transport dangerous goods by road.

The training focuses on compliance with regulatory requirements for the safe transport of dangerous goods. While successful completion of this unit is a mandatory requirement for licensing, additional industry-specific training may be required to fully meet legislative obligations
