

TLIF0006 – Administer a Fatigue Risk Management System (Fatigue for Schedulers)

OVERVIEW

Learn to administer and monitor a fatigue risk management system (FRMS) during work operations in line with national and state/territory requirements. The unit covers implementing fatigue controls, recognising breaches, and developing staff competence so schedules and rosters keep people safe and compliant.

COURSE CONTENT

- Identify fatigue hazards and early warning signs in scheduling contexts.
- Implement and monitor fatigue controls in rosters, trips and tasks.
- Recognise and act on breaches of fatigue policies, procedures and regulations.
- Develop and assess staff competence in fatigue management.
- Collect data and report on FRMS implementation and outcomes.

DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT

Blended delivery (theory + practical application). Assessment may include questioning, observation/demonstration, portfolio/projects and short written tasks. A simulated or workplace environment reflecting real scheduling conditions is required for practical components.
