March 11 is a teacher workday. No school for students.



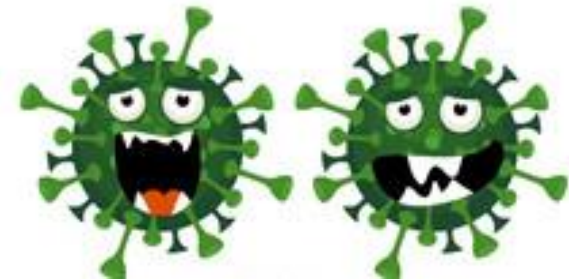
2022-2023 REGISTRATION Is now open!
