**George Dewey (1837-1917) served in the United States Navy. As a veteran of the American Civil War, Dewey is best known when he was commodore of the United States Navy's Asiatic Squadron at the Battle of Manila Bay. With war declared between Spain and the United States, Dewey led his squadron in an attack against the Spanish Pacific Fleet anchored in Manila Bay on 1 May 1898. The victory was total; every Spanish warship was sunk, while the Asiatic Squadron suffered minor damage and one casualty.**



**As a result of the battle, and the winning of the Spanish-American War, the United States and its navy became a global power. In recognition of his leadership, George Dewey is the only US naval officer to obtain the rank of Admiral of the Navy. Admiral Dewey is the founder of the Naval Order of the United States in 1890.**
