Hopewell Music connects and empowers the North Minneapolis community through high-quality music programming that is accessible to all, regardless of age, ability, background, or circumstance.



Our Students & Families



About our community

Located in the Webber-Camden neighborhood, Hopewell is part of one of the most diverse and vibrant parts of Minneapolis. 63% of participants in our lesson, ensemble, and outreach programs identify as People of Color. Hopewell Music has a strong sense of family and community, with 149 families enrolled. 49 of those families have more than 1 family member in lessons and ensembles.



Over 20 total free public performances from our lessons and ensemble students

Lesson and Ensemble Programs

160 students total were enrolled in our lessons program and 60 community members participated in our ensemble program in 2019. Participation in our ensembles is free, and we provide scholarships for more than half of our lessons students. Our sliding fee scale is based on the federal school lunch program income guidelines. Our full price lesson rate is \$25, and we charge \$15 for reduced price students and \$0 for full scholarship students. We also offer instrument rentals for lessons students, with reduced rates for scholarship students.

58% of students received a scholarship

Community Partnerships

In 2019, Hopewell partnered with 5 libraries and parks to present bucket drumming classes for 27 total participants. Hopewell also presented approximately 50 community concerts in partnership with Northside libraries, churches, care centers, and other organizations.

In 2019, we saw a 25% increase in number of donors with 346 Individual Donors contributing \$95,985 to our much-needed programs.
