



On-Site Lesson Policies

These policies are subject to change and will be reviewed & updated regularly as the situation continues to evolve.

Hopewell will offer a limited number of on-site lessons for vaccinated students, per teacher availability.

On-Site Lessons Procedure:

- Students and any accompanying adult or family member must be fully vaccinated.
- Students may be accompanied by one adult or family member.
- Students and their accompanying adult or family member must wear a mask while on-site. KN95s or equivalent masks are required, cloth or surgical masks at this time are not permitted.

Vaccination Policy

- **Staff , Teachers, Volunteers:** Administrative staff, teachers, and volunteers working on site must be fully vaccinated.
- **Students and Families:**
 - a. Students and their accompanying family member must be fully vaccinated.
- Fully vaccinated means that an individual has received all recommended doses of a COVID- 19 vaccine including recommended boosters that has received Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) or full approval from the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and that it has been at least two weeks since the final recommended dose. Currently, the FDA recommends a 3rd booster dose 6 months after the 2nd dose.

Masking Policy

- Masks are mandatory for on-site lessons. All teachers, administrative staff, students and their one accompanying adult or family member must wear a mask.
- KN95 masks or equivalent are required. Cloth or surgical masks at this time are not permitted. There is a limited number of masks available on-site.
- Students studying wind instruments may remove their mask during the lesson time but are asked to replace it following their lesson time



On-Site Safety:

- Teaching spaces will have an air cleaning system running at all times.
 - a. If it is possible to have a window open, then an open window and a fan will suffice
 - b. Air cleaners shall be run in addition to air conditioning in warm weather.
- Teachers are not permitted to work on-site if they are showing any signs of illness, including, but not limited to fever, sore throat, muscle aches, congestion or headache.
- Administration will notify on-site staff immediately if they have been exposed to any infected person while working at Hopewell. All high-touch surfaces will be sanitized and rooms will be allowed to air out or run unoccupied with the air purifying system running
- Students should not come to any on-site activities if they are showing any signs of illness including, but not limited to fever, sore throat, muscle aches, congestion or headache.
- Hopewell reserves the right to refuse service to any student exhibiting signs of illness.
