Acceptance / Rejection - Dwight & Sons ("D&S" hereinafter) reserves the right to reject, change or cancel all or part of this agreement at any time due to unacceptable payment performance or credit of the Owner/Customer. D&S may accept late payments, partial payments, checks, bank drafts, or money orders marked "Paid in Full" without waiving any of it's rights related to this agreement.

Approval - Until approved, this proposal is subject to change without notice and is automatically withdrawn if not accepted by the Owner/Customer within 20 days after its issue.

Alternate Bids - The Owner/Customer has the option to obtain alternate bids for additional work not contained in the contract, provided that obtaining the bids does not unduly hold up completion of the project. will be held harmless for damage to the property during this bidding period. In emergency situations if the Owner/Customer is absent from the work site, is authorized to proceed without formal notification to the Owner/Customer. The Owner/Customer will be responsible to any additional costs incurred as a result of any additional work performed by in emergency situations. However, shall be responsible for documenting the performance of this additional work.

Cancellation Policy - The Owner/Customer may cancel this transaction, without penalty or obligation, at any time prior to midnight of the third business day after the date of this transaction. After the expiration of the three-day period, D&S shall retain sole discretionary power regarding canceling this transaction. It is not the desire of D&S to force home improvement products and services on a buyer who is reluctant for whatever reason to receive the goods and services contracted for. However, in order to protect an investment in time spent and materials orders, D&S may require forfeiture of deposits or additional payments from the buyer depending upon the time frame when the desire to cancel becomes known to D&S. If the buyer wishes to cancel the transaction after the three-day cancellation period has expired but before materials have been ordered,

D&S shall be entitled to a 15% (of total job cost) cancellation fee. Upon notice, the Owner/Customer is responsible to immediately make the Final Inspection and approve or disapprove the work by returning the Customer Satisfaction Rating Form; or notifying D&S in writing of any work considered incomplete or not satisfactory. If written notice of dissatisfaction is not received within one week by D&S, the project is considered completed and accepted by the Owner/Customer.

Company Responsibility - D&S shall provide necessary labor, materials and sales tax on materials to complete the project as specified. D&S may in its discretion substitute materials to be used in the work, provided all substituted materials are that of equal kind and quality. All surplus or salvageable materials remain the property of D&S.

Company Insurance - D&S shall provide Workers Compensation, Public Liability, Property Damage and Complete Operations insurance for the project unless such insurance in whole or in part is supplied by a general contractor, sub-contractor or owner. Damage to the building or its contents, during or after construction or during the warranty period shall be covered by these insurances. D&S's maximum liability is limited to the coverage provided.

the character provided for in the Contract Documents, then notice by the observing party shall be given to the other party promptly before conditions are disturbed and in no event later than 21 days after first observance of the conditions. Owner/Customer will promptly investigate those conditions and advise Owner and D&S in writing if further surveys or subsurface tests are necessary. Promptly thereafter, Owner will obtain the necessary additional surveys and tests and furnish copies to Owner/Customer and D&S If Owner/Customer finds that the results of such surveys or tests indicate subsurface or latent physical conditions differing significantly from those indicated in the contract documents, a change order shall be issued incorporating the necessary revisions.

Escrow Account - In the unlikely event the Owner/Customer is dissatisfied and desires to withhold payment Appending resolution, D&S at its option may accept an escrow account in lieu of pre-payment. The escrow account will contain the full balance owed. Acceptance of such an account will delay the Owner/Customer from becoming delinquent or the Owner/Customer being in default of their contractual responsibility. Natural Ponding - Incidental Ponding of water on a flat roof is a natural condition as the flat roof.

membrane conforms to the existing structure. Water Ponding less than 72 hours does not negatively affect the performance of the roof system. However, if Ponding occurs beyond 72 hours the Owner/Customer should consider the investment in positive drainage to extend the performance of the roof system.

Natural Conditions - Removing permanently attached building materials often disturbs and vibrates the existing structure. The debris generated from this process, and related procedures, may cause inconvenience or discomfort. The Owner/Customer will confirm in writing to D&S headquarters any warranty claims within ten days of discovering any defect or failure of the work to properly perform. Certified Mail is considered proof of notice.

Owner/Customer Insurance - The Owner/Customer agrees to carry Homeowners Insurance, covering fire, theft, and storm, in sufficient amounts to cover work and materials under construction by D&S. and agrees to compensate D&S for losses sustained by these conditions.

Payment - Payment of invoices for services rendered is expected within ten days of receipt of any invoice. If invoices are not paid within ten days after receipt, they will accrue interest at a rate of 12% per month. Owner/Customer will be responsible for paying all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney's fees.

Project Sequencing - D&S is responsible for establishing scheduling and sequencing of the work to be performed. D&S shall not be held responsible for delay, non-delivery, discontinuance, default in shipment by a supplier in whole or in part, loss in transit, strikes, lockouts or other conditions beyond the control of D&S. The Owner/Customer agrees to pay for the completed work, if portions are delayed, due to these reasons. In the event of significant delay, change and price increase involving labor, material or equipment through no fault of D&S the contract amount, time of completion and/or other contract requirements shall be adjusted equitably by change order.

Substantial Completion - The date as certified by Owner/Customer when the construction of the project or a specified part of it is sufficiently completed, in accordance with the contract documents, so that the project or specified part can be utilized for the purposes for which it was intended, or if there be no such certification, the date when final payment is due in accordance with the terms of Contract. Payment is due upon substantial completion of the work.
