

Apply the following rates of fertilizer in the spring and during the middle of the growing season. Water your plants after fertilizing.

## **Container Gardening:**

 $4'' \text{ pot } = \frac{1}{4} \text{ cup}$  $6'' \text{ pot } = \frac{1}{2} \text{ cup}$ 

 $12'' \text{ pot } = \frac{2}{3} \text{ cup}$ 

Mix the fertilizer and potting soil together in the spring. Apply the fertilizer at the surface of the potting soil mid-season.

## Traditional Gardening:

 $1\frac{1}{2}$  lb per 10 row ft or  $\frac{2}{3}$  cup per plant. Apply the fertilizer 3 to 4 inches from the plants at planting and repeat during the middle of the growing season.
