

Fertilizer Gold Blend

Gold Special Starter 2-4-2

Gold Special Starter is specially formulated as a starter or pop up fertilizer. Readily available phosphorus speeds germination and promotes rapid and vigorous growth. This is advantageous in areas with a short growing season or on heavier soils in a wet season. On soils testing low to medium phosphorus, it is most efficient in a band application. Use as a starter over a wide variety of crops, especially corn, small grains, seed beds and where strong root growth is required. Includes Boron and Zinc. Approximate bulk density 62 lbs/cu ft.

Fertilizer Super Blends

Super N 4-2-4

Super N is specially formulated as a multipurpose plant food. It provides readily available nutrients to get the germinating seedling off to a fast and vigorous start, while supplying time-released nutrients that continue to feed the crop through the entire growing period. Because of the unique formulation of Super N, the entire plant food requirements of a crop can be applied in the row. Available with and without added Boron, Boron and Zinc. Approximate bulk density 59 lbs /cu ft.

Super K 3-4-7

Super K fertilizer is blended to meet the demands of higher phosphorus and potassium requirements by certain crops. It performs much like a combination of Super N 4-2-4 and Gold SS just with higher available potash. The phosphorus helps get germinating seedlings off to good start and the extra potassium helps finish the crop. Super K is also blended with crab meal for nematode control. Super 3-2-3 is suited for most plant food applications. It is particularly well formulated for gardens and is very effective for spring plantings. It will not leach away. Lawns: As a general purpose fertilizer, it is able to activate the microbial life in the soil which aids in thatch reduction. This product is for soil high in Phosphorus and low in Potassium. Approximate bulk density 71 lbs/cu ft.

Blue N 5-1-1

Blue N is an advanced formulation providing a time-released nitrogen in a multinutrient fertilizer. Blue N was specially formulated for crop production that requires more nitrogen and when manures and legume rotations are used on a minimal basis. Blue N should be applied in broadcast application and plowed under or worked into the soil. Blue N will provide maximum growth and assure you of a strong finish. If phosphorous levels in the soil are low, then a starter fertilizer should be used in conjunction with Blue N. Available with and without Boron. Approximate bulk density 52 lbs/cu ft.

Aragonite 0-0-033Ca

Aragonite is a sea calcium that is exceptionally high in calcium and low in magnesium. Many soils have had dolomite lime added for years and the magnesium may be tying up other nutrients in the soil. Gypsum and aragonite should be used to off set a high mag content soil. Approximate bulk density 98 lbs/ cu ft.

• Bag (5 lb, 50 lb), Tote (2,000 lb)

Gypsum (Calcium Sulfate) 0-0-0 23Ca 17S

Is an outstanding soil supplement for soil lacking calcium, but the pH is adequate or high. Gypsum will loosen the soil, encourage soil life, and add the needed calcium. Calcium also acts as a weed deterrent as most weeds prefer acid soils. The sulfur when combined with water will form a weak sulfuric acid which will release calcium that is tied up in the soil solution. This is quick reaction product. Approximate bulk density 54 lbs/cu ft.



Many of our fertilizers will work well for Berries but Fertrell Berry Mix 4-2-4 is specifically designed for berries with added Zinc, Boron, and Sulfur.

Blueberries

Blueberries thrive in acidic soil (4.5 to 5.1 pH range).

- In the early spring before leafs are fully out apply Fertrell Berry Mix 4-2-4 to give the plants a boost prior to leaf and berry production.
- Between July and September, we recommend a one time application of Holly Care 4-6-4 to provide a high phosphorous fertilizer with sulfur with plenty of time for the roots to absorb them.

Brambles: Raspberries, Blackberries, Black caps, etc.

- In March apply Aragonite followed by an April application of Berry Mix 4-2-4.
- Between August and October apply Berry Mix 4-2-4 once. The nutrients will be absorbed in the plants' roots preparing the plants for heavy fruit production the next spring.

Strawberries

Tips for Taking Soil Samples

- Soil samples should be taken from the top 6 inches of the field.
- Samples should be taken from several areas of a field. These samples should represent the good and poor areas in that field. The size of the field determines the number of samples.
- Samples should be mixed in a clean plastic pail with a wooden stick and poured into a plastic bag or the bag provided by the lab.
- We recommend that samples not be touched by hands without gloves.
- For row crops, the best time for sampling is after the crop is mature or harvested. Hayfields, pastures and lawns may be sampled anytime when the temperature is above 40° F.

 Soil test should be taken at least every 2-3 years, however under certain circumstances yearly samples maybe necessary.

Note: Soil probes are not contained in the test kit.

SAMPLING INSTRUCTIONS

Analytical results are only as good as the sample, please follow instructions below.

- Avoid contamination by using clean hands and clean containers.
- Collect enough material to fill the sample bag (about 1 pint).
- All bagged samples should be placed in a larger plastic bag for shipment.
 Squeeze the air out of the bag and tie it shut. If shipping is delayed for more than one day the samples should be frozen.

Silage Samples

- When filling your silo, take 3 to 5 handfuls of silage from each of several loads.
- From store silage: Do not collect off the top. Either dig down 2 to 3 feet or collect freshly unloaded material. Take 3 to 5 handfuls from different locations.

Concentrates and Grain

• Take 5 to 6 random cup sized samples from different locations in the mixture.

Hay Samples

- It is best to use a forage sampler. They take a sample 11/8" in diameter by 18 inches long.
- Different 'batches' should be kept separate and tested separately.
- Samples should be taken from about 15-20 bales. Square bales: probe from the end into the center.
- Stacks of hay: probe at random 15 to 20 times.
- Round bales: also collect 15-20 probes by probing from the outside diameter toward the center.

The Fertrell Company History

Fertrell has enjoyed a long history starting in 1946 out of a passion for excellence. John Johnson of Fullerton, Maryland a suburb of Baltimore, was greatly dissatisfied with the blooms and fragrance of his roses. Determined to improve fragrance, appearance and endurance of his roses John set forth mixing plant, animal, and mineral rock powders. This passion for excellence is what started The Organic Development Company. The first name of Fertrell as we know it.

As the company grew it was apparent that more space for manufacturing would be necessary. Lancaster county Pennsylvania had a growing demand for Mr. Johnson fertilizer blends. For this reason, The Organic Development Company relocated to its current location in Bainbridge, PA. in 1961. The Lancaster County sales were greatly influenced by the sales of Rufus Miller, a local to Bainbridge, PA. Also, in 1961, when the company moved to the current location, was the beginning of liquid fertilizer blending. Liquid fertilizers at the time were primarily a blend of liquid fish emulsions.

In 1973, ownership changed and along with this change the name of the company changed to The Natural Development Company. The new owner Rufus Miller changed the name again in 1975 to The Fertrell Company. Fertrell is a combination of other words pertaining to good soil health and fertility – Fertilizer – FER, Trace minerals – TR, and Elements – ELL, to form Fertrell.





In 1974, Fertrell's customers encouraged Mr. Miller to develop vitamin & mineral supplements for their livestock. This was the beginning of the Fertrell Nutri-Balancer line of livestock supplements. The addition of livestock supplements became more apparent due to revealed shortages of mineral in the soil test of the farmlands. Fertrell was one of the first to use probiotics, dried seaweed meal and chelated trace mineral for livestock and poultry supplements. In 1974, this was cutting edge technology to the animal nutrition world.

Rufus Miller continued as owner of The Fertrell Company from 1973 to 1991. In 1991, three employees, David Mattocks, Dennis Nygard and Reuben Gantz joined together to purchase Fertrell from Mr. Miller. This partnership lasted until 1996 when Mr. Nygard retired. The other two partners remained until 2000 when Mr. Gantz also retired. David Mattocks continued as sole owner until 2003. In 2003, David Mattocks entered Fertrell into an ESOP – employee stock owner-

ship program. An ESOP was the best option for ensuring Fertrell products and services for the next generations of farmers, gardeners, and all the Fertrell community.

The Fertrell Company has been blessed for over 77 years with the best customers, great employees, and visionary leaders. It has seen many pivotal milestones along the way. From the beginning with one man's passion, to a handful of inspired entrepreneurs, to now over 25 employees that all have a level of ownership in one of the greatest organic fertilizer companies ever. With the help of great mentors like Jack Robinette for assisting with the formulation of Poultry Nutri-Balancer, the insight of Dr. Robert Patton for the development of Rumi Cult 40 — now RC Gold 4X. The partnerships with world renowned spokesperson Joel Salatin who has been using Poultry Nutri-Balancer since the spring 1997.

Fertrell from its humble beginnings in one man's garage in Maryland, to small mixing, blending and bagging facilities in Lancaster County Pa, to now 25 plus



employee-owned company. Fertrell now sells and distributes through dealers and directly to all the U.S. states, Canada and Abroad.

Guidance to Peak Bang for the Buck

I had a great conversation with a customer earlier this morning. I thought you may be interested in hearing what he had to say. Basically, he is NOT certified organic, so he would be considered a conventional style farmer. However. John has worked with Fertrell fertilizers with his produce operation for several years now. He explained how he and a group of 8-10, mostly conventional, farmers get together monthly to talk shop. This last time, they put together some cost of production sheets. And they did some itemized percentages of cost on their operations, and John's came in amongst the lowest, once again. He said that he often questions working with us being that he is not certified organic. But this, along with the success of, "using 600-900#s of Fertrell dry fertilizer blends per acre, is not bad." Basically, he really sees a lot of bang for his buck with working with Fertrell, and I feel like this is one of those type testimonials that you're interested in.

One issue I think Fertrell always combats, is exactly that. Many folks see/hear the word "organic" and just immediately think high priced. Guidance to Peak Performance

"I'm sure nearly everyone in this group is already familiar with how awesome Fertrell is and how helpful the crew over there is with sharing information, so this is kind of beating a dead horse but I thought I'd share some of the specifics of my broiler season stats and how impactful Fertrell has been for our farm.

Last year I started mixing my own soy free ration with pretty horrific results. At the beginning of this year I reached out to Fertrell and got some help. We've been raising 50 Cornish Cross per month since February and we just increased production to 50 every two weeks. It took me a lit-

tle while to go 100% all in on the ration. Originally I had been going lower on the fish meal than was suggested to me and I wasn't adding the oil because I hadn't found a good supply of oil that wouldn't destroy my food costs.

So we kind of tiptoed into the full ration but even doing so we had great results. Now that we're 100% all in, our feed bill is more expensive per lb, but we're feeding far less feed and also getting to butcher weight about 10 days faster than we were at the beginning of this season. At 7 weeks we're getting 5 lbs dressed weights with 14 lbs of feed consumed per chicken.

Along the way to getting here I started doing control groups because I saw where one person had said they occasionally can't get Nutribalancer so they use kelp. I noticed Kelp was the first ingredient in Nutribalancer so I gave it a try. In 2 experiments our chickens finished 3.6 oz heavier on average when fed Nutribalancer than when fed just kelp. We're in a lucky situation where Nutribalancer is less expensive than kelp anyways since we're able to source it from a feed mill who sells to us at just slightly above cost.

We did one experiment only where the chickens got no Nutribalancer or kelp and we ended up losing 2 more chickens out of 25 than we did with Nutribalancer and finished weights were 8.3 oz lower on average. The Nutribalancer is a relatively expensive ingredient but each chicken eats about 50 cents worth of Nutribalancer in its lifetime and gives us \$2.50 more (we sell our chickens for \$5/lb) in finished product to sell.

My lesson learned is to not tiptoe into trusting the crew over there but to just dive in and know that you'll get the absolute best performance out of the chickens that way. When something seems a little questionable (most recently I got a layer feed ration with 8% fat which seemed nuts to me, but the chickens are doing great on it and I'm excited to see how they produce over the next few weeks), just do it and evaluate why afterwards rather than being slow to adopt something that you'll eventually be getting to anyways."
