INFORMATION

Cost:

The cost varies by course/age division and is posted on social media events and registration. We do not accept cards. Payments are made at the registration table not to the course.

Tee Times:

Tournament start times will be posted on social media events/calendar events/etc and will vary by event and age group

Check In:

Players MUST check in no later than 30 minutes prior to tee time.

Registration:

Pre-registration is highly appreciated

Age Divisions:

- **15 - 18** age group will play 18 holes *(recent high school graduates are able to play the summer following their senior year prior to their 19th birthday / in order to gain more exposure to college coaches)*
- **14 - 11** age group will play 9 holes *(Players can choose to play up in the higher age division but once a player establishes their age division, they can not accumulate championship points in another age division)*
- **10 - and younger(co-ed)** will play 9 holes *(Players can choose to play up in the higher age division but once a player establishes their age division, they can not accumulate championship points in another age division)*

Caddies are welcomed and encouraged for all players

Players are expected to walk the course

2022 Thunderbird Junior Series Tour Championship:

All Junior Golfers are able to play in the Tour Championship, and win medals. However, to qualify for the overall Tour Champions trophy, golfers must play in at least 2 summer series events. (Not including Tour Championship Tournament or the Caddie & Kid)

Regular Season Events:

(Medals are given to the first 3 places at the regular season tournaments)

Tour Championship:

(Medals are given to the first 3 placers and an overall tour champions trophy presented to each age groups's overall points champion, points double for the Tour Championship Tournament)
