Wayne County Historical Society, home of the full-size replica of the Stourbridge Lion, the first locomotive to run on commercial track in the Western hemisphere. Our Main Museum and Museum Shop are housed in the 1860 headquarters of the Delaware and Hudson Canal Company. The D and H Gravity Railroad, which carried anthracite coal from the mines of Lackawanna County to Honesdale, met the D and H Canal directly behind the building. The canal carried the coal from Honesdale to Rondout, New York, on the Hudson River. There are also options to visit the Old Stone Jail, Bethel One-Room Schoolhouse, and Daniels Farmhouse at Lock 31 on the D and H Canal.
