General Requirements

- 1. Individuals may enter only one State event in the same category.
- 2. Use your "contest age" September 1^{st} of last year.
- 3. Ages for Individual Events: 3-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15, 16-23, 24 & up
- 4. Ages for Novelty Events: 3-5, 6-9, 10-13, 14-23, 24 & up
- 5. Awards for Individual Events: 5 (five) places
- 6. Awards for Corps and Teams: All groups will be placed out and receive awards.
- 7. Contestants for State Championships must have been a member of the World Twirling Association for a minimum of 30 (thirty days) and have competed in at least two WTA Open contests, providing contests were held within a 200 miles radius of contestant's home.
- 8. More complete rules are detailed in the WTA Rulebook. Please consider purchasing a Rulebook (\$15.00) and/or consulting a WTA Teacher.

State Corps and Team Championships

The following groups events are offered: Parade Corps, Show Corps, Strut Line Team, Twirling Team, Dance-Twirl Team, High School Line, Dance Line, Show Team, and Pom-Pon Team.

Ages for Groups: 3-5, 6-7, 8-10, 11-13, 14-23, 24 & up (be sure to use "contest age" – September 1st of last year). Send in your entry form, check or money order, and two lists: #1 – <u>List the names and ages of each group's members</u> on a separate piece of paper, and #2 – List the date and place of at least two Open contests each group has competed in during the current contest season by the Deadline listed at the top of this brochure.

State Beginner Individual Events Championships

The following individual events are offered for Beginners: Fancy Best Appearing, Basic Box Strut, Fancy Strut, Novice Solo, and Beginner Solo

Novice title: Enter Basic Box Strut, Novice Fancy Best Appearing, and Novice Solo (no more than 3 first place wins in solo twirling).

Beginner title: Enter Beginner Fancy Best Appearing, Fancy Strut, Beginner Two Baton, and Beginner Solo (no more than 8 first place wins in solo twirling).

State Intermediate Individual Events Championships

The following individual events are offered for Intermediates: Intermediate Fancy Best Appearing, Fancy Strut, Intermediate Two- Baton, and Solo Twirling.

Princess title: Enter the above events (must not have won over 15 first place wins in solo twirling).

State Advanced Individual Events Championships

The following individual events are offered for Advanced performers: Advance Fancy Best Appearing, Fancy Strut, Advance Two- Baton, and Solo Twirling.

Queen title: Enter the following Advanced events – Fancy Best Appearing, Fancy Strut, Advance Two-Baton, and Solo Twirling.

State Novelty Championships

The following Novelty events are offered: Show Routine, Individual Dance-Twirl, Flag Twirling, Three-Baton Twirling, Duet Twirling, Duet Dance/Twirl and Fancy Strutting Duets.

Anyone may enter Novelty events so long as the general requirements are met (see Rulebook). Also, a contestant in the 24 & up division must enter Advanced.

State Boy's Division Championship

State Title for Boys – ages 3-9, 10-13 & 14-23

Enter the following events for overall Boys Title – Military Box, Solo Twirling, 2-Baton & routine with more than 2 batons routine. Boys can also enter individual events for Solo Twirling and 2-Baton.
