OHIO STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Championship Events

1. Individuals may enter only one State event in the same category.
2. Use your “contest age” – September 1st of last year.
3. Ages for Individual Events: 3-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15, 16-23, 24 & up
4. Ages for Novelty Events: 3-5, 6-9, 10-13, 14-23, 24 & up
5. Awards for Individual Events: 5 (five) places
6. Awards for Corps and Teams: All groups will be placed out and receive awards.
7. More complete rules are detailed in the WTA Rulebook.
8. Must be a resident of the championship state.

State Corps and Team Championships

Parade Corps, Show Corps – 10 + members

Strut Line Team, Twirling Team, Dance-Twirl Team, High School/Collegiate Line, Dance Line, Show Team, and Pom-Pon Team.

Sizes are Small 3-5, Medium 6-9, and Large 10+.

Twirling Team and Dance Twirl is offered in Novice** and Advanced levels.

Ages for Groups: 3-5, 6-7, 8-10, 11-13, 14-23, 24 & up (be sure to use “contest age” – September 1st of last year).

**** Novice contestants may not perform/attempt more than a 2-spin (under flat or vertical toss).**

Toss cartwheel, a toss illusion in any direction, a toss walkover, a toss somersault or any form of “gymnastics” under a toss is NOT permitted. 5 point penalty per infraction.

****Beginner contestants may not perform/attempt more than a 3 spin. 5 point penalty per infraction.**

OPEN EVENTS – OPEN TEAMS for Out of State Teams ONLY.

Group Age Divisions (average): 3-5 (Tiny Tot), 6-7 (Miniature), 8-10 (Juvenile), 11-13 (Junior), 14-23 (Senior), 24 - up.

Awards: Trophies to all corps and teams.

1. Parade Corps - 10 or more, marching precision around floor, 3-6 minutes.

2. Show Corps - 10 or more, marching, twirling, novelty, 6-8 minutes.

The following teams are offered in SMALL 3-5 members, MEDIUM 6-9 members, and LARGE 10+ members

3. Strut Line Team - 3 or more, marching down floor & back (Fancy Strut Format), 3 minutes maximum.

4. Novice Twirling Team** - 3 or more, unison twirling 3:00 minutes max salute to salute

5. Twirling Team - 3 or more, unison twirling 3:00 minutes max salute to salute

6. Novice Dance-Twirl Team** - 3 or more, twirling while dancing, 3:00 minutes max

7. Dance-Twirl Team - 3 or more, twirling while dancing, 3:00 minutes max

8. High School or Collegiate Line - 3 or more, members from same high school or college, 2-6:00 minutes.

9. Dance Line - 3 or more, jazz, hip-hop, and etc. (see rulebook), 3:00 minutes max

10. Show Team - 3 or more, novelty equipment, dancing, 3:00 minutes max

11. Pom-Pon Team - 3 or more, pom-pons, dancing, 3:00 minutes max

** Novice teams may not perform/attempt more than a 2-spin (under flat or vertical toss).

Toss cartwheel, a toss illusion in any direction, a toss walkover, a toss somersault or any form of "gymnastics" under a toss is NOT permitted. 5 point penalty per infraction.

#12, 13 & 15 only open to Out of State Contestants.

Novelties that run immediately following group competitions – (Age Divisions: 3-5, 6-9, 10-13, 14-23, 24 - up)

12. Individual Dance-Twirl - creative individual dance twirl using 1, 2 and /or 3 batons to own music, 3 minutes maximum.

13. Show Routine – creative routine with theme, novelty equipment, dancing, own music 3 minute maximum

15. Duet Dance-Twirl - creative duet dance twirl using 1, 2 and /or 3 batons using contest music, 3 minutes maximum.

Individual Age Divisions (unless otherwise specified): 3-5, 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15, 16-23, 24 - up.

Contestants 24 - up are eligible to compete in advanced events as well as novelty events, and rating events.

Awards (unless otherwise specified): 1st place trophies, 2nd – 3rd place medals, more if warranted.

16. Special Beginners Box Strut - never have won a 1st place in any strut.

17. Beginners Box Strut - must not have won over eight 1sts in any strut.

18. Advanced Box Strut – recommended for those who have won over eight 1st s places in strutting events

19. Parade Box - parade routine once around square.

20. Miss Majorette of the Month - members, model gown or party dress in "T," 1:30 minutes maximum, 1st-3rd places qualify for World's Most Beautiful Majorette Pageant. Once qualified, you should wait until after the pageant to enter again.

21. W.T.A. Queen - model gown or party dress in "T," 1:30 minutes maximum.

23. Beginner Fancy Best Appearing - "T" modeling,, 1:30 minutes maximum, must not have won over eight 1sts in FBA

24. Advanced Fancy Best Appearing - "T" modeling, fancy costume, baton, 1:30 minutes maximum.

25. Rating Fancy Strutting - rating event, 2:00 minutes maximum

26. Novice Fancy Strutting - not over three 1st place in Fancy Strut, 2:00 minutes maximum.

27. Beginner Fancy Strutting - not over eight 1sts in Fancy Strut, 2:00 minutes maximum.

28. Intermediate Fancy Strutting - not over 15 1sts in Fancy Strut, 2:00 minutes maximum.

29. Advanced Fancy Strutting - 2 minutes maximum.

31. Rating Solo Twirling - rating event, time same as solo level.

32. Challenger Solo Twirling – 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute – (for special needs solo twirlers) Div. 3-II & 12-23

Solo – Girls and Boys divisions:

33. Novice Solo Twirling** - not over three 1st place in solo, 1-2 minutes.

34. Beginner Solo Twirling** - not over eight 1sts in solo, 1-2 minutes.

35. Intermediate Solo Twirling - not over 15 firsts in solo, 1:45 - 2:15 minutes.

36. Advanced Solo Twirling - 2-2:30 minutes from salute to salute.

** Novice contestants may not perform/attempt more than a 2-spin (under flat or vertical toss).

Toss cartwheel, a toss illusion in any direction, a toss walkover, a toss somersault or any form of "gymnastics" under a toss is NOT permitted. 5 point penalty per infraction.

**Beginner contestants may not perform/attempt more than a 3 spin. 5 point penalty per infraction.

2 Baton – Girls and Boys divisions:

37. Rating 2 Baton - rating event, 2:00 minutes maximum

38. Beginner 2 Baton**- must not have won over eight firsts in 2 Baton, 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute

39. Intermediate 2 Baton – not over 15 firsts in 2 baton, 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute.

40. Advanced 2 Baton - 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute.

Novelty Events (Age Divisions: 3-5, 6-9, 10-13, 14-23, 24 - up)

41. 3 Baton - three or two and three baton twirling, 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute.

42. Flag Twirl - 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute.

43. Duet Fancy Strut - 2 minutes maximum from beginning to end of routine using contest music (run during Fancy Strut)

14. Duet Twirl - unison twirling, 2 minutes maximum from salute to salute, run during solo and 2 Baton events
