Old Business:

*** Bennett & Dobbins will be rescheduled to train for the fiscal year 2026 year-end budget. To date, the invoice from Bennett & Dobbins in the amount of \$12,820.00 for prep of June 30, 2026 fiscal year taxes and PSC Report was split into two payments.**
