This is providing there are no gravity and flow issues, and the property is habitable. Council needs to consider this, but this would be a huge undertaking to determine which properties this applies to and could alienate the Town's citizens.
- 2. Review/Discuss Consider Zirkle v. Town of Lumberport, Dismissed on 3/3/25 She is once again residing on Pooz Street. Council approved on 10/21/24 to remove cinder blocks from in front of alley (blocks to date have not been moved). Attorney Simmerman made recommendations on 10/17/22 but the Town did not move forward with recommendations.
