


**MSPB** – click on link "Decisions" at top and then select any of the three options: case reports, nonprecedential decisions, or precedential decisions.








### **EEOC** - click on "Federal Sector" link.

# **Federal Sector Appellate Decisions**

Employment discrimination complaints in the federal government are handled by the agency involved. If the individual who filed the complaint does not agree with the agency's decision, he or she can file an appeal with the EEOC.
