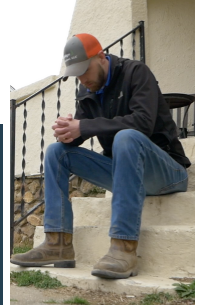

The Bethesda Center is a Christian-based, non-profit organization designed to help local people in need. Located in Ashland City, this food bank and thrift store it is a mission of the Cheatham County Ministerial Alliance and directed by our own Ronnie Anderson. (2.50%)



Hope Center Ministries

Directed by Stephen Palk, the Hope Center Ministries is a non-profit that operates a Christ-centered recovery program for alcoholics and addicts in Springfield, TN. (2.50%)



Directed by Shawn Elmore, the mission of the Open Door Pregnancy Center is to empower women and their families who are facing or have faced unexpected pregnancies to make life-affirming decisions through education, counseling, and support regardless of life choices, age, race, or religion. (2.50%)

The Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions is the annual state missions offering that provides invaluable financial support for ministries that help reach Tennesseans for Christ. The offering is named after W.C. & Mildred Golden, who suggested the week of prayer for state missions and a state missions offering in 1902.

Tennessee Baptists contributing through the Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions provide support for Tennessee ministries; sustaining state ministries not funded through the Cooperative Program.

The Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions is meeting human needs through Compassion Ministries. Its Disaster Relief helping restore a community after a storm. Its Baptist Collegiate Ministries sharing the hope of Jesus on Tennessee college campuses. It's reaching the spiritually lost in Tennessee through evangelism. And so much more.

NATIONAL GOAL: \$70 MILLION

The Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (AAEO) is the primary way we support mission efforts in North America. One hundred percent of gifts given to AAEO are used to support Southern Baptist missionaries serving across the United States and Canada.

Annie Armstrong was unstoppable in her passion for missions.

Annie Armstrong (1850-1938) was born in Baltimore at a time when there was little opportunity for women. Yet, her devotion to Christ led her to a life of service and leadership. She organized women to pray, to give and to meet the needs around them. She challenged pastors and churches to action and rallied vital support for missionaries. Ultimately, Annie was recognized as a trailblazer for her visionary leadership that still inspires millions today.

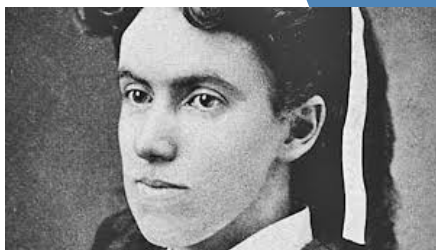
