IMPORTANT DETAILS

The Pangea Inclusive Spelling Bee will take place at the main branch of the Pickering Public Library located at 1 The Esplanade South, Pickering on November 8 and 9, 2025.

All spellers are asked to attend on November 8 at 09:30 hrs, to prepare for set up.

Spellers aged 7-9 will be the first group to run through the bee in its entirety until finished.

Spellers aged 10-12 will be the second group to run through their bee after the first group competition has been completed.

If necessary, the bee will continue: November 9.

OFFICIAL SPELLING BEE RULES

Spellers may ask the judges for: alternate pronunciations, language of origin, definition, part of speech, use in a sentence.

Spellers have two minutes to spell the word. Please spell slowly so judges can hear your attempt properly.

You may restart but you must repeat the letters you already spelled before you continue to finish.

Correct attempts will receive a verbal confirmation of "correct," and incorrect attempts will receive a bell tone.

In an elimination process, after the first incorrect attempt, you are out of the competition.

If two final spellers both incorrectly spell a word or both correctly spell a word in the same round, they proceed to another round. The speller who is the sole correct speller in the same round, is the winner.

Winners in each age category will be awarded the Pangea Inclusive Support Spelling Bee Champion Cup and prizes donated by our sponsors.
