The white and whimsical renovation of this early 20th-century kitchen is the product of a masterful collaboration between designer and previous owner Nikki Roche and Marc Giffre of Ironwood Joinery. For a seamless modern look, integrated appliances were concealed by sleek Laminex cupboards in Dulux White on White, which have the added benefit of providing loads of storage. "The appliance cupboard is fabulous—I can hide everything in it," says Nikki. With a minimalist palette set off by luxurious Superwhite quartzite across the benchtops and splashback, the kitchen follows a traditional work triangle layout for intuitive functionality.
