RENTER'S POST-RENTAL CLEANING RESPONSIBILITIES

In the peer-to-peer rental industry, it is customary for renters to return the RV in the same, or better, condition of clean as it was received. Therefore, we've created this list to help you understand our cleaning expectations.

INTERIOR

- 1) Remove all personal belongings from all
 - a) storage compartments / bins (don't forget the exterior storage bins)
 - b) cabinets / shelves
 - c) drawers
 - d) wardrobe / closet(s)
 - e) bathroom medicine cabinet
- 2) Remove all food from
 - a) cabinets / pantry
 - b) refrigerator
 - c) microwave / convection oven
 - d) oven
- 3) Wipe
 - a) wipe-down all hard surfaces (countertops)
 - b) wipe-out refrigerator (especially sticky spills)
 - c) wipe-out microwave
 - d) wipe-out oven
 - e) wipe-down stove-top
- 4) Clean
 - a) clean-up any "splatter" or spills on the walls
 - b) outdoor grill & grilling utensils (*if used*)
 - c) any obvious dirt from shower / tub basin
 - d) any waste stains in & around toilet(s)
- 5) Wash
 - a) any dishes used
 - b) any pots & pans used
 - c) microwave's glass plate
- 6) Place ALL used linens (i.e., sheets, towels, etc.) in the shower
- 7) Take all trash & recycling out of the RV and dispose of properly
- 8) Sweep
 - a) RV's "house"
 - b) RV's "cab" (motorhomes)
- 9) "Wet Swiffer" / sponge-mop ALL hard floor surfaces (especially seek-out all sticky spills)

EXTERIOR

- 1) IF necessary, wash RV with low pressure at RV/Truck Wash to remove excessive amounts of
 - a) dead bug remains (if present on RV's front fascia, headlights & grill, and/or windshield)
 - b) mud / dirt / road salt

CAUTION – Risk of Damage: Motorhomes (and tall RVs) will NOT fit in a self-service carwash bay!

- 2) Spray-off with hose
 - a) plastic picnic / tailgate table (if provided with rental)
 - b) all muddy/dirty tires and/or rims
 - c) any spillage in sewage compartment/area
- 3) Remove all debris, dirt, sand, and any trash from exterior storage compartments / bins

PROVIDED CLEANING EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES

- ✓ disposable paper towels ✓ all-purpose cleaner (usually Pine-Sol / Fabluoso)
- ✓ broom & dust pan ✓ "Swiffer Wet Jet" w/ pads -or- basic sponge mop
- ✓ disposable disinfecting wipes ✓ window/glass & mirror cleaner (usually Windex)
- ✓ microfiber clothes ✓ toilet cleaning wand w/ disposable cleaning pads

[IMPORTANT – DO NOT FLUSH: disposable paper towels, cleaning pads, disinfecting wipes, etc.]
