Fall Trail Ride Highlights

On Saturday, October 11th and Sunday, October 12th the



Barre Riding and Driving Club held its annual Fall Trail Ride from Felton Field. The traditional Friday evening potluck was well attended, and many hot dishes were enjoyed at the Red Food Booth. With lows in the high 40s and clear skies, it was a pleasant and quiet fall evening for those who chose to camp overnight.

trail ride. Day riders enjoyed made-to-order complimentary breakfast of Egg McFeltons (fried egg, ham, and cheese on a toasted English muffin) along with freshly made home fries and accompanied by fresh coffee or tea. Most riders tacked up and rode out by 10am.

The well-marked trails began at Felton Field, 115 Old Coldbrook Road, in lovely Barre, Massachusetts, an area where the Barre Riding and Driving Club has operated for 85 years, carrying on the traditions started by an original group of dedicated horse enthusiasts. BRDC offered 6-, 10-, & 13-Mile Trail Routes consisting of gravel roads, rail bed, and wooded trails.

All trails for the day had been marked with colored ribbons to guide the riders along the prescribed routes. Marianne Wojcicki provided riders with a single map page with detailed routes of the trails for additional guidance. Many thanks go to our trail ride crew who helped with clearing trails, marking trails with ribbons or taking down ribbons post-ride.










BRDC offers the only local trail ride event that includes hot lunch options including meatballs, stews, chili, and soups along with salads and a variety of sandwich options. Meals were included in the ride fee and included a selection of delicious desserts.

After relaxing in the afternoon, about twenty members and guests opted to stay at the Red Food Booth to have the traditional Saturday night turkey dinner that included all the fixings and sides. Following that, guests mingled around the campfire to enjoy the traditional warming drinks and to share stories.

On Sunday the fickle New England weather promised rain by the afternoon, so after a repeat of the fine breakfast, most riders and guests packed up and headed home. The Club is NEHT affiliated, allowing riders to add miles toward their trail riding goals.
