
















## **Installation of Street Crossing Safety Lights Completed**

The RRFBs (rectangular rapid flashing beacons) have been installed at 196 Williamsville Road in Hubbardston, MA where the Ware River Rail Trail crosses Williamsville Road. Thanks go to our Board of Directors and to Mark Kresge for their support of this effort.

However! Although these features will do a great deal to increase the safety of hikers, bikers, and horses and riders making use of the trails, please use extreme caution at this crossing. First, the crossing beacons are new, and it will take time for regular road traffic to become aware of their presence. Notice in the photo the advice to "wait for gap in the traffic". Second, even when the lights are flashing, the typical speed of vehicles may make it difficult for vehicles to note the flashing lights and respond in time. The Board of Directors urges users of this crossing to proceed with extreme caution, especially since the sign indicates bikers and hikers so traffic may not be expecting horses to cross.


