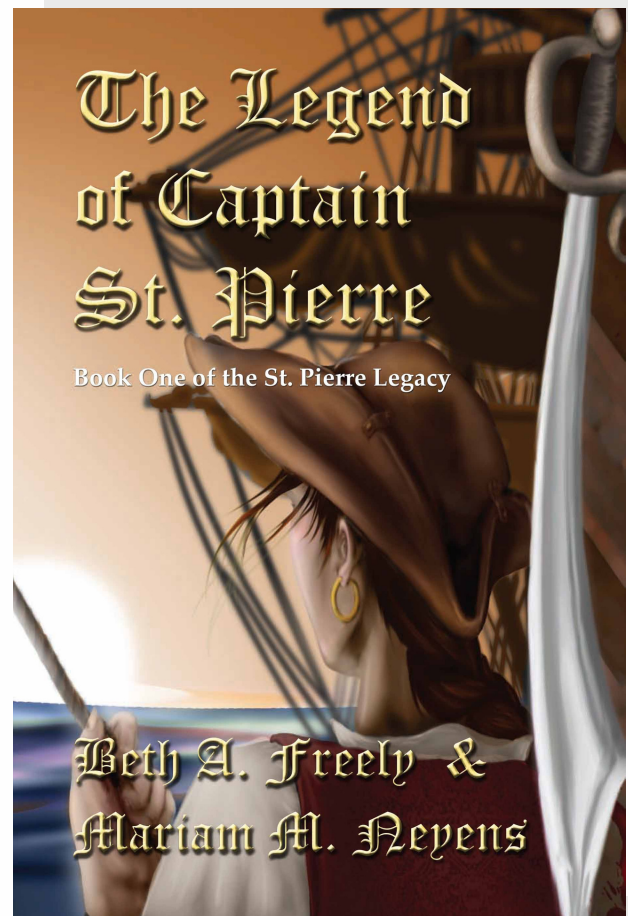


THE LEGEND OF CAPTAIN ST. PIERRE
