First Step Shelter in Daytona Beach is a transitional facility dedicated to helping single adults experiencing homelessness in Volusia County. Since opening in 2019, it has provided shelter, case management, employment support, and healthcare coordination to assist individuals in achieving stable housing. The shelter also operates a 24/7 Safe Zone as an alternative to incarceration and continues to expand its services to meet growing community needs.

By partnering with community organizations, the shelter addresses residents' medical, social, mental, occupational, and financial needs, facilitating their transition into permanent housing.
