Rehearsals will be following worship the Sundays before (1st and 3rd Sundays).





### **Dramatic Rescue at 45 feet!**

The other day I arrived at the church on a mission: a mission to collect aerial views, using my quadcopter drone, above and around our small campus for possible future inclusion in First Lutheran's pictorial history. My drone contains a built-in high-quality 4k video camera that has collected spectacular shots from the Upper Peninsula of Michigan to the San Diego shoreline over the past four years.



So, from the north parking lot I launched my DJI Mavic Pro, as the manufacturer calls my drone, into the air. The first sixty seconds of the flight were flawless. It sprang immediately skyward as I steered it about forty feet up to cross Date Street (it was clear of traffic, of course) and positioned it to overlook the church's east side, its most photogenic side, from about sixty feet above, bathed in the pale light of the morning sun. Unfortunately things went downhill from there.

Flying over a very tall pondarosa pine tree, I lowered the drone into a better position. From my viewpoint in the parking lot, it looked like I had cleared the tree. But I hadn't. I guess my depth perception was a little off, and before I knew it, I watched my "toy" snag a pine branch and quickly tip off-balance, dropping and vanishing into a thatch of needles. Well, that didn't look good, I thought. My drone's sensors are supposed to warn me when it's perilously close to an object, but it must've taken the day off.

After reluctantly concluding that rescuing a pricey drone was going to cost me some money, I contacted Julio Tree Care & Landscaping. Then (thank you, Joy) I contacted Cathy, the manager of the townhouse complex, near where the tree and my drone were standing over. Cathy was most cooperative in making arrangements for me, Julio and his tree care professionals to enter the townhouse complex.

Julio's guys wasted no time while his main guy, clad with ropes and other protective gear, scurried up the tree, quickly reaching the highest branches. With the foliage being pretty dense at the top, he had to look around for several minutes until. Eureka! He found it!!

Julio's guy was good! Clutching a safety rope in one hand and my drone AND a reacher stick in the other, he slid back down the tree and handed me my drone in nearly pristine condition, save for a drop of harmless pine tar on its top side and a little dust on the propellers.

All's well that ends well, right? Needless to say, I won't be in such a hurry next time. It costs too much!

Our PR consultant showed Council some ideas for new signage at the front of the church.


Traci moved and Sharon seconded to end meeting.
