## Diocesan Appeal and Healing and Reconciliation Appeal Update

This week we got to just over 88% of our diocesan goal in pledges, reaching \$176,353 in contributions which will go to our smaller parishes, missions and ministries. In addition, parishes received another \$6,700 in donations that will go back to the parishes, for a total of nearly \$64,000 in rebates once those pledges are received.

I note that Christ the King Parish jumped 14% and is very close to meeting their parish goal, and Immaculata in Burns Lake is at 90%. St. Anthony's in Houston is only a couple percent away from their goal -- well done! And Resurrection Parish is almost at 75% -- well on their way to meeting their goal.

A number of other parishes have continued to build on their goal and have been increasing the amount that they will receive in rebates.

I am very pleased to announce that we are almost at \$60,000 in our Healing and Reconciliation Appeal. We continue to work on plans as to how those funds will be used, and the dialogue is continuing.

Thank you to everyone who has contributed to these important needs of our diocesan family, whether in financial or spiritual contributions. We ask you to keep these needs in your prayers.
