
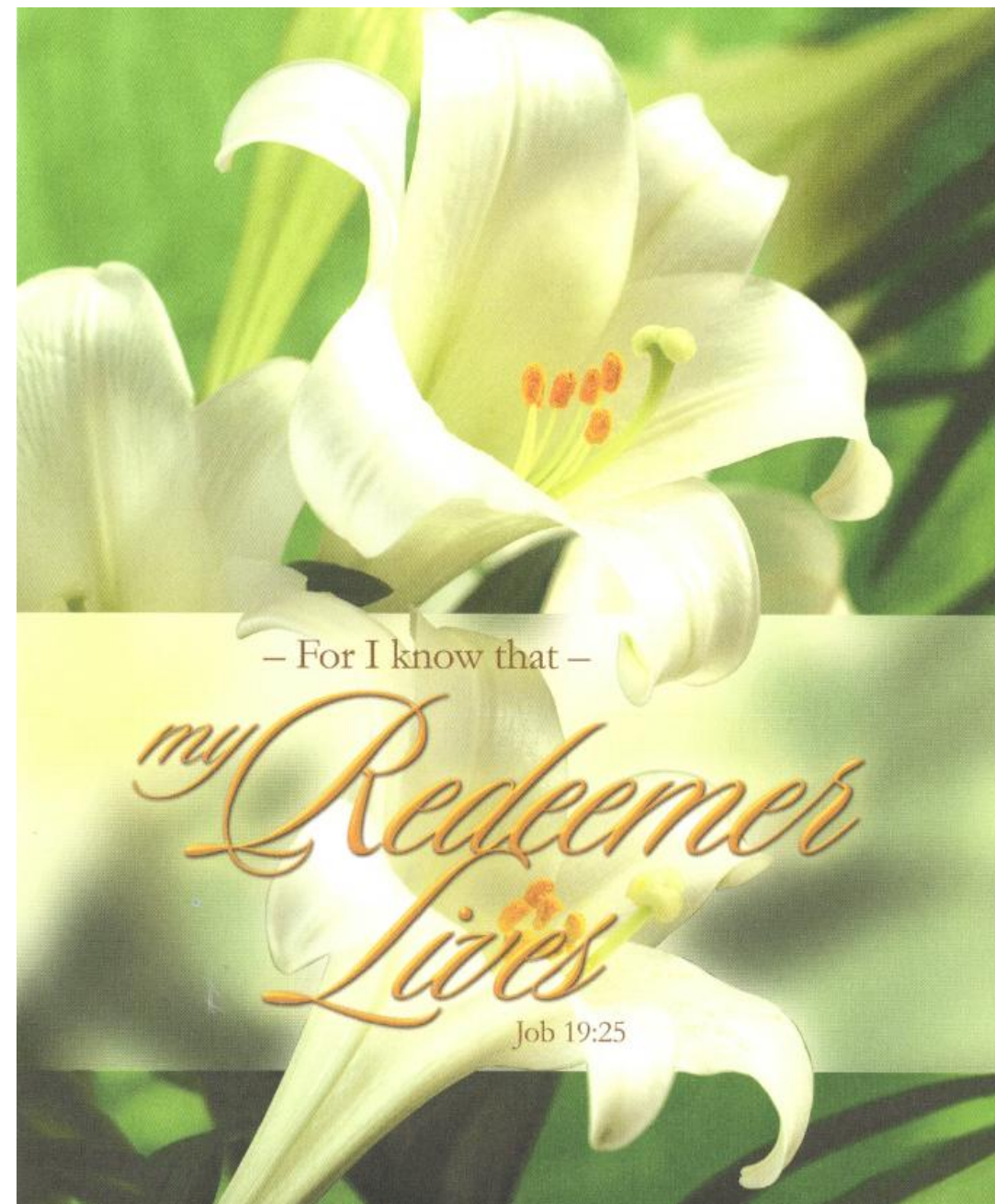





A Prayer for Easter Eyes

THE VIEW FROM WHERE YOU STAND

Imagine yourself in the Jerusalem marketplace Easter afternoon. Have you heard? That teacher who was crucified on Friday, his body is missing! People readily share "facts": a rock rolled away, linens in a pile, no body inside. Voices raise as people state their positions: It was a thief, a horrible crime. No - a hoax, a fanatic's trick. Though suspicious of each other, the crowd clumps together unified in disbelief, trusting their news, their facts, (real or imagined) unwilling to recognize a miracle, because skepticism and doubt are so much easier.

Now step inside the upper room. Here prayer and mourning have given way to celebration. The Messiah is risen! Scripture is fulfilled and salvation has come to the world. The painful events of Friday's crucifixion have melted into a miracle of resurrection, giving new hope to Jesus' followers. Suddenly they are energized: there is great work to do, a world to reach with the good news! Eyes filled with love and hope beam from every face in a room filled with believers, believers in the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.
