

Pastoral Care Training Sessions – Fall 2025

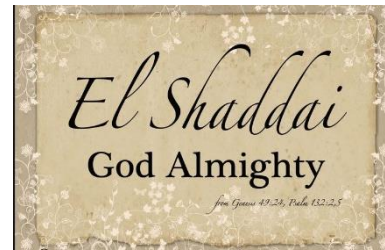

2025-2026 Diocesan Annual Appeal Parish Goal is \$25,921.
