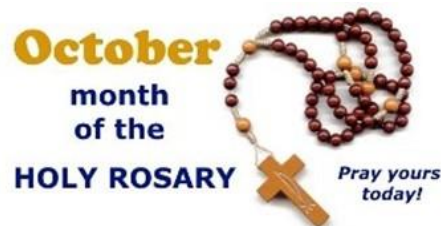

All Saints Day

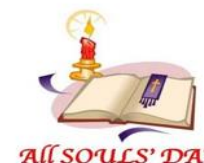


They will receive blessing from the Lord and vindication from the God of their salvation. Psalm 24:5

All Saints' Day is a celebration of all Catholic saints held on **November 1** each year. "On this solemnity, we recall the holy men and women who,

having completed their earthly journeys, now live forever with God. These saints, though not canonized, offer us models of abiding faith and love of God and neighbour."

All Souls' Day is a day for commemoration of all the faithful departed, those baptized Christians who are believed to be in purgatory because they died with the guilt of lesser sins on their souls. It is observed on **November 2**. Roman Catholic doctrine holds that the prayers of the faithful on earth will help cleanse these souls in order to fit them for the vision of God in heaven, and the day is dedicated to prayer and remembrance.



Everyone is invited to pray for the faithful departed of the Parish, and their loved ones who have died, and for all the dead, especially those who died alone and are unknown.
