- 4. Parishioners are reminded that they DO NOT NEED a security question because the donation is automatically deposited into the designated parish account.

## HAITI NEWS

First, let me thank everyone that has supported St. Jean Bosco School in Jeremie Haiti. Your support has, and continues to be, a blessing to the students at the school.

I wanted to give you a heads up that effective July 1, 2024; sponsorship fees and/or donations will no longer be collected through our Parish for Notre Dame Haiti.

Income tax receipts will no longer be issued from Notre Dame Parish for any fees collected after June 30. Any money collected after June 30,2024, income tax receipts will be issued from the Society.

The money will continue to be sent to our school in Jeremie, Haiti, from the Board of Trustees from our new Society. The previous society is being dissolved because of the recent deaths of two board members. The sponsorship fees and any donations made to Haiti will continue to be sent to St. Jean Bosco School, with the only difference being the money will not be going through Notre Dame Parish. Yvonne will be in touch with you in the next few weeks, with the new information where you will send your money for sponsorship or donations to the school in Jeremie starting July 1, 2024.
