

The Advent Wreath



The traditional Advent wreath with its rich symbolism recalls the long wait of our ancestors for the promised Savior and ritualizes our own hope for His second coming. The

wreath itself, a circle without beginning and end, reminds us of eternity. The evergreen branches symbolize God's unchangeableness. And as a new candle is lit each Sunday we call our hearts to a new awareness, a fresh anticipation of His birth in Bethlehem.
