

Ash Wednesday reminds us that life will have an end and calls us to turn to back to God for real happiness in this mortal life. Thus Lent calls us to two powerful actions: turning away from sin, and also turning back to God. Simply treating Lent as a time of fasting and penance gives us only half the story.
