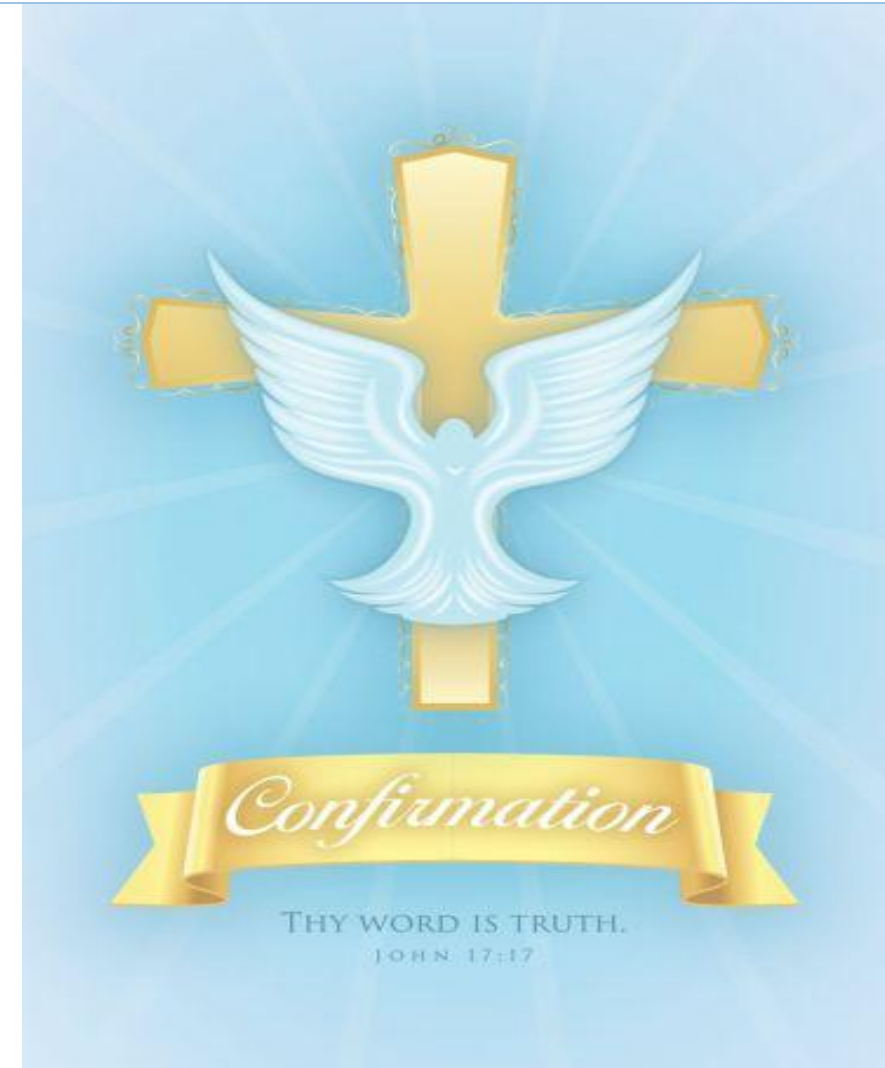

#### THE ROLE OF PARENTS IN THE SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION OF CHILDREN:

At Notre Dame Parish, we are committed to the idea that taking an active part in a child's spiritual formation is the right and dignity of Christian parents. **Parents are the "first teachers" of their children in the vision and practice of the Christian way of life.** As part of the Baptismal ritual states: "In asking for Baptism for your child, you are undertaking the responsibility of raising him (her) in the faith..."

It is in the home, the appropriate place, that children primarily experience and come to know about God. When children experience the loving care of their family members, when they are challenged to be the best people that they can be by their parents, and when they witness a family's unceasing striving for healing and reconciliation, then children really learn about who God is.

#### CCCB Statement for the 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Legalisation of Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide ("MAiD")

The Standing Committee For Family and Life of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has issued a statement marking the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the legalisation of euthanasia and assisted suicide in Canada. Bill C-14, which legalised euthanasia and assisted suicide under the term "MAiD", was passed on June 17, 2016.

In its statement, the CCCB offers statistics and concerns about the continued expansion of "MAiD" and its impact on vulnerable Canadians.
