- Clean thistles, tumbleweeds, and other debris from fence lines, tree rows and barriers.
- Barb wire, chain link and other fences and barriers
- One pass operation each side of fence
- Will not damage fence wire or posts
- Leaves chopped material in windrow that will blow away or can be baled



- Minimum tractor horsepower is 50, recommended is 70 hp or larger
- Tractor should have a 1000 PTO for the machine pump to run on (a 540 PTO works with an adapter)

Fence line after cleaning

- Normal operating tractor PTO speed for efficient pump operation 540 – 600 RPM
- Tractor should have at least 2 remote hydraulic coupler sets (3 coupler sets would be better)
- Use remote hydraulics to raise and lower machine.
- Picker can be tilted to match fence angles with 2nd remote hydraulic
- Use 3rd remote hydraulic to swing hydraulic hitch tongue
- Occasionally lightly touching wire and posts does not hurt fence or machine
- Remove all debris, rocks, loose wire and posts in path of machine
