Patriotic Masonic Flags Available

Bro Elsworth Barrington has arranged for an Afghani artisan to make patriotic Masonic flags, like that shown above. This is slightly different from the one he recently gifted the Lodge. They are available for purchase by contacting him (see below). They cost \$60 to produce, plus delivery charges.

They can be delivered in one of several ways:

- · USPS from an Army post. From there, it normally takes about three weeks. Cost is either \$14.35 or \$18.45, depending on circumstances, and he doesn't know for sure until he mails it.
- · Local mail if you can wait until he comes stateside. The cost would \$7.65.
- He can hand-carry it to the Lodge, but he's not here very often.
- He could meet you somewhere when he's stateside.
