Whence comes the Due Guard?

It is a symbol of obligation; a reminder by him who uses it to all who see him do so that he remembers his promises. Masonic authorities are not in complete agreement as to the derivation of the words, although they unite as to what the words signify. Mackey thinks the words mean "to duly guard against." Other authorities are convinced the phrase has a French derivation coming from "Dieu Garde"—God guard (me or you).

It is universally used as a salute to the Master before the Altar and to the Wardens during the conferring of a degree.
