OUR MISSION is to support the LGBTQIA+ community and its allies, focusing on LGBTQIA+ youth and young adults. We aim to promote organizations who are accepting of all people, regardless of sexual orientation and/or gender identity. We also strive to build a community of individuals to create and strengthen friendships and business relationships.

OUR GOALS include the ability to help fund and support LGBTQIA+ student clubs in local schools, to network and promote buying with local businesses and organizations that support Union County Pride's mission, and to inform the community of events in order to promote opportunities to network with other like-minded people.









In 2022, Union County Pride, Inc. hosted the area's *first-ever Pride events*, inviting a change in the perception of the county as a home for the LGBTQIA+ community. Support and enthusiasm have been overwhelming positive!









In 2022, Union County Pride, Inc. was established as a nonprofit corporation and received 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status from the Internal Revenue Service. A board was formed and a website was created (UnionCountyPride.org), including an online process for registration of vendors, partners, sponsors, and event attendees.


