Achievements





Union County Pride, Inc. partnered with Queen City Performing Arts to bring the criticallyacclaimed production, "Hello, Daddy!" to downtown Monroe, NC in March 2024. The show not only captivated audiences, but also sparked meaningful conversations surrounding gender identity and acceptance. The influx of visitors invigorated the local economy and fostered opportunities for new connections and the challenging of societal norms. Despite facing initial protests and city council pushback over its inclusion of drag performances, the play garnered widespread acclaim and raised over \$6275, which was used to benefit local organizations dedicated to promoting LGBTQ+ rights and supporting marginalized communities, further amplifying the show's message of inclusion and empowerment.





Community Grants, Scholarships, and Awards

Union County Pride awarded several scholarships to LGBTQ+ students pursuing higher education. Additionally, grants were provided to local LGBTQ+ student clubs, supporting their initiatives to promote inclusivity and awareness within educational institutions. We also presented awards of appreciation to local advocates, allies, and activists who demonstrate their commitment to strengthening and empowering the LGBTQ+ community.



Advocacy and Outreach

Our organization actively participated in advocacy efforts, addressing discriminatory legislation and promoting policies that protect LGBTQ+ rights. Collaborations with local businesses, faith-based organizations, and educational institutions have strengthened our community presence and impact.

Our 2024 conference expanded in scope, addressing critical issues such as mental health. legal rights, and educational challenges faced bv LGBTQ+ the community. Workshops and panel discussions provided attendees with practical tools and knowledge to navigate these challenges effectively.

Sessions addressed the impact of legislation such as North Carolina's SB49 Say Gay" law "Don't on LGBTQ+ and provided students training on important such suicide issues as prevention as well as strategies for evervdav advocacy. Speakers from several local organizations such as Equality NC and the Gender Education Network contributed their expertise to the discussions.
