

GREASE TRAP ENFORCEMENT REGULATION 2.0

- (a) Definition: \underline{FOG} : Any \underline{F} ats, \underline{O} ils and/or \underline{G} reases in quantities that, if discharged into the municipal sewer collection system, may potentially cause harm to the municipal sewer collection system.
- (b) No Customer may discharge FOG into the municipal sewer collection system.
- (c) Any customer that has been found to be in violation of section (b) shall first be issued a written warning of the provisions of the Sewer District's Grease Trap regulations by the District. Any customer who then subsequently violates the provision of section (b) shall be issued a written violation, and pursuant to § 8 of P.L. 1972 Ch. 146, be fined by the Superintendent fifty dollars (\$50.00) for every day that such violation shall continue.
- (d) In addition to the provisions of section (c), the Superintendent may act to prevent FOG from leaving a customer's premises, and/or from discharging into or through the municipal sewer collection system, including a preventative pump-out of the system. The rate of labor for employees and third-party contractors may be charged as an assessment of \$200 per event pursuant to § 7 of P.L. 1972 Ch. 146 and prior grease trap regulations.
- (e) This regulation is to supplement, and not repeal, any prior grease trap regulations.
- (f) Any assessment or fine under the provisions of this regulation, or prior regulations, may be appealed within thirty (30) days of issuance to the Board of Sewer Commissioners, at which time the alleged offending customer may present evidence and argument.
